2011 In-competition testing statistics

The ICF is responsible for Anti-Doping testing during ICF Competitions which includes Junior and Senior World Championships and World Cups in all disciplines. The ICF performed 193 in-competition tests. Of these 193 tests 3 Positive tests were reported.

Out-of-competition testing statistics (CCES and WADA)

The ICF Out-of-Competition Testing Programme is delivered through the Canadian Centre for Ethics in Sport - Anti-Doping Service (CCES) - Anti-Doping Service (cces) was performing Anti-Doping testing on behalf of the ICF in 2011. The organisation use local Anti-Doping Agencies or other service providers to collect athlete samples for tests.

A total of 133 out-of-competition tests were performed by ANADO-ADS and WADA on the ICF's behalf in 2011. Of these tests, 4 were reported as missed test.

1st quarter: 2 missed tests, 1 filing failure

2nd quarter: 1 filing failure

The statistics reported for the ICF in-competition and out-of-competition programs cover tests that are initiated by the ICF or its representatives. These statistics do not include in-competition and out-of-competition testing initiated by National Federations, National Anti-Doping Organisations or Major Event Organisers (such as Regional Games).
