THE 2016 WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS IN BRANDENBURG, GERMANY



The 2016 World Championships is soon coming up from 16th to 18th September. Masters World Cup will take place 13-14 September.

IMPORTANT: We remind you that the deadline for numerical entries is 31st August and for nominal entries 2nd September.

We have concerns about the number of entries in some of the C-boat classes.

We are trying to encourage more teams to enter, but there is no guarantee that we will get the necessary boats from 6 national teams which is required for a class being a Championships class.

This are the numbers from the numerical entries which we have so far, however we are still missing entries from countries like ESP, CZE, CRO, and UKR:

C1 Men Junior:	5	(FRA, GER, HUN, POL, POR)
C1 Junior Women:	5	(GER, HUN, POL, POR, SRB)
C1 Women:	5	(ECU, FRA, HUN, POR, SRB)
C1 Men u23	5	(FRA, GER, HUN, ITA, POL)
C2 Men:	3	(HUN, POL, POR)
