
II. GENERAL INFORMATION

1. City introduction

Tehran is the capital of Iran and Tehran Province. With a population of around 8.3 million and surpassing 14 million in the wider metropolitan area, Tehran is Iran's largest city and urban area, and the largest city in Western Asia. The city is home to many historic mosques, churches, synagogues and Zoroastrian fire temples. However, modern structures, notably Azadi (Freedom) Tower and the Milad Tower, have come to symbolize the city. Tehran is located at 35.41 north latitude and 51.15 east longitude and 1,200 meters above sea level, which makes it a little cooler than other capitals in the Middle East. The "RIAL" is the currency of Iran. Although the "TOMAN" is no longer an official unit of Iranian currency, Iranians commonly express amounts of money and prices of goods in "tomans". For this purpose, one "toman" equals 10 rials. Despite this usage, amounts of money and prices of goods are virtually always written in rials. The standard electrical voltage in Iran is 220 volts AC, 50Hz. Travelers may need a transformer for any appliance or electrical equipment to three-pronged UK-style plug. Tehran is the hub of almost all bus, train and air services. Every town and city of any size is directly linked to Tehran – always by bus, usually by air and increasingly by train too. Tickets from Tehran can sell fast so book as soon as you know when you're leaving. 



1. Numerical entries: closing date June 20, 2019

2. Nominal entries: closing date July 5, 2019

Please ensure you add the number each player will wear in the box to the right of the athlete name when submitting your entries.

V. PARTICIPATION FEE FACILITIES

With the goal of encouraging national federations to participate in the competition, the organizing committee of the 2019 ACC Canoe Polo Asian Championships has negotiated with some sponsors to cover part of participation costs excluding airfare and other travel expenses to or in Iran. Following subtracting the costs covered by the sponsors, the participation costs are presented in the next page.

Moreover, if one NF participates with more than one team, the second, third and fourth teams will pay 50% of registration cost per person.









VI. PARTICIPATION FEE

1. The registration fee would be 100 USD per person.

2. Accommodation:

- Triple room, 55 USD per person per day;
- Double room, 70 USD per person per day;

3. 25 USD for meals and other facilities including:

- Three meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner;
- A competition packet (containing T-shirt, souvenir, etc);
- Transport by shuttle bus between the venue and the hotels;
- Transport airport to/from hotels;
- Medical care at the venue;
- Supply of water at the venue;
- Insurance during the competition
- Fees for the use of venue and it's facilities;
- Wifi at the venue;
- Security service at the venue;
- One day city tour

1. Visa

For those participants who need visas to enter Iran kindly requested to send a photocopy of the first page of their passports and fill out the Visa Info Form (Form II) then send them together to the ICRSF.

2. Insurance and medical care

All participants are strongly advised to have appropriate medical insurance from their respective countries.

A first aid and Emergency Medical Service will be available at the venue. A Hospital nearby the venue will be on standby to cover the needs during the event. All situation of hospital service provided in our public health care must be paid directly by the athlete or by National Federation.

3. Boat rental

Participants must bring their standard equipment and boats. For boat rental, please contact the organizing committee.

4. Anti-doping

It is compulsory for athletes to complete the online anti-doping education course prior to competing in international events, which includes continental championships. After completing your entries, follow the instruction from the link below to view which of your athletes have already completed the education, and which athletes still need to complete the course. Currently in SDP only athlete records are updated with completed certificates.
