3. Team leaders meeting

The Team Leaders' meeting will take place on Wednesday 28 August at 18:15 in the Media Area (tent next to the OVR).

4. Sports Information Office

- Sports Information Office is located above the OVR (2nd floor of the containers next to the finish area) and is open from Monday 26 August from 9.00 to 18.00 each day until Sunday 1 September.
- The phone number from the office is +49 / 160 / 365 44 72.
- Team boxes are located at the Sports Information Office.

5. Official training

- The venue will be open for Official Training from Monday 26 August until Thursday 29 August.
- The official training schedule is available via the ICF World Cup event page:

- Different courses designs will be set-up every day by the Organising Committee; please do not move any of the gates during training.
- Water safety won't be provided by the Organising Committee.

6. Training bibs

- Team accreditations and training bibs can be collected by Team Leaders from the Sport Information Office.

7. Entry list verification, national anthem and flag sign off

- Whilst collecting training bibs Team Leaders will be asked to check and sign off their entry list, national anthem and flag with the Sports Information Office team.
- From the start of the official training until 10:00 on Wednesday 28 August, each team leader must check and sign their entries list at the race office.
- All changes or withdrawals have to be done on this entry list and signed by the team leader.

8. Venue – key services

A. Parking

Team Parking will be located in the South of the venue next to the Teams Quarter & Area (see appendix 2).

Teams will be issued with parking passes via Sports Information Office.

B. Team Areas

NF containers are located in the South of the venue next to the parking area.

Boat storage is located in the Teams Area as well as at the venue (Sattelplatz).

We will provide the following services for athletes:

- Wireless internet (at the venue and Teams Area during the event period)
- Toilets (Team Area and at the venue)
- Shower (at the venue)

C. Medical Services location and availability

Medical care will be provided by German Red Cross during the event period.

There will be an ambulance & medical point during the competition near the OVR.

All athletes and team staff must have valid medical insurance. All costs of the participants medical cure will be covered by themselves.

9. Venue – Accreditation and security

A. Accreditation to the Venue

- The Accreditation Office is located at Officials Area/Sport Information Office.
- Accreditation will be required from Friday 30 August when access control commences.

B. Security

- The venue is a gated area and will be closed from 22:00 to 07:00 every day.
- There will be surveillance during the night.
- The Organising Committee recommends not leaving anything valuable in the tents, containers, cars or at the competition venue.
- The Organising Committee will not accept liability in case of theft or disappearance of equipment from the site.

10. Extreme Canoe Slalom boats

The Organising Committee will provide a pool of boats for Extreme Slalom athletes to use.

We will provide ten boats from the following types: PRIJON CURVE / PRIJON PURE

To borrow boats please visit the Sport Information Office.

11. Extreme Canoe Slalom – Time trials

The time trials will be organised Wednesday 28 August at 17:15.

The start list will be published Wednesday 28 August at 14:00.

Start from the ramp and finish line as for Canoe Slalom.

Bibs will be available at the ramp from 17:00.

12. Catering

During the event period we offer the following dishes for lunch for the teams served in the catering tent in the Teams Area:

- Friday, 30/08/19: Pasta with arrabiata sauce or spinach-cheese sauce
- Saturday, 31/08/19: Vegetable rice with meatballs or quinoa burger
- Sunday 01/09/19 Tortelloni with vegetable sauce or tomato sauce

The costs per dish are 12 EUR.
