13. Bib Distribution

A. Canoe Slalom Events

- CSL Competition bibs will be available from the Sport Information Office from 11.00 on Thursday 29 August.
- A bib deposit of 50 Euro per set per nation is required on collection of the bibs.
- CSL Competition bibs must be returned to the Sport Information Office following the competition for the return of the deposit.

B. Extreme Canoe Slalom Events

- For CSLX time trials phases bibs will be distributed in the start area on Wednesday from 17.00.
- For CSLX final phases bibs will be distributed in the start area on Sunday from 14.30.

14. Canoe Slalom events – race information

A. Pre start procedure

- There will be a clock facing the lake at the bottom of the conveyor belt.
- The conveyor belt takes approximately 40 seconds.
- During the competition there should be only 3 athletes in the start pool including the athlete at the start position.

B. Start



#ICFslalom

- Athletes may move to the start position once the previous Athlete has broken the beam but must be at the start position 15 seconds before their start.
- The start position is located between the blocks in the start pool marked by a start backdrop.
- Athletes must start facing downstream.
- The beam line is located at the top of the first drop.
- At the start, there will be a countdown clock (**right** bank) showing the time to start. There will be an acoustic signal (10 seconds before start - 4 shorts, 1 long - start).
- Athletes must start **within 3 seconds of** their start time.



Red light → the athlete **can't** leave the start position



Green light → the athlete **can** leave the start position

- At all times, the athletes must follow the Starter's instruction, or they may be disqualified for the run.

C. Finish



- The finish beam is marked by the two green poles on the banks.
- Athletes must exit via the stair on the left of the finish pool to pass through equipment control, kiss and cry and the mixed zone.
- Athletes must not leave the finish zone until dismissed by the Equipment Control Judge once they are no longer needed for the ceremonies, anti-doping or equipment control.

#ICFslalom

- During the finals, the leading athletes must proceed to the “Kiss and Cry” area located after equipment control where TV will interview them.
- There will be access to the broadcast feed in this area. If they drop out of the lead the new leaders will replace them.
- They then proceed via the mixed zone back to the Athlete area.

15. Extreme Canoe Slalom events – race information

A. Final phases

Pre-start procedure

- Athletes need to be at the start area 30 minutes prior to their heats to prepare their boats and receive their bibs and final instructions.
- Athletes may warm up in their own CSLX or slalom boat or a CSLX boat provided by the organiser
- Access to start ramp will be right side.

Start Procedure

- Athletes should be settled in the start position on the ramp 1.5 minutes before their start time.
- They should then listen to the sports presentation where they will be introduced to spectators.
- During this time, they should face the TV camera. At all times they should follow the starters instructions.
- The start position is with paddle in one hand to allow athlete to push off to start.
- Boats will be held at the start position.

Finish

- Finish line will be in the pool below the spectators stand.
- After the finish please go to the dedicated area indicated on the course design map.
- Wait there for 30 secs to gather with other paddlers from your run (for TV) and then exit to kiss and cry zone – there will be someone to let you know if you were qualified for next phase.
- Please bring back the boat, spraydeck and bib to the start as for time trials (see official communication 1).
- HOC volunteers will be there to support you.

Rules reminder

Gate negotiation

16.21.3 - The whole head and both shoulders of the athlete must cross the gate line in accordance with the correct side of the gate and the course plan.

Safety rules

16.25.1 - Athletes are not permitted to push or hold back other athletes or kayaks with their hands or paddles.

16.25.2 - Kayak to kayak contact is permitted but athletes are not permitted to ram their boats into another athletes body.

16.25.3 - Athletes are not permitted to deliberately reach across another Athletes body with their paddle.

16. Technical Video Service – set up schedule

- The Technical Video Service will be available at the TVS tent from 14.30 on Thursday to Sunday 16.00.
- Please ensure your team comes between 14.30 and 16.30 on Thursday 29 August to check their equipment with the signal.
- Remember: to ensure all the systems are working under full load, Teams need to be set up at least 30 minutes prior to the competition each day – even if you are not competing until the afternoon.
- During demonstration runs **only** full length will be filmed and distributed.
- Team members must stay outside the cameras view during the filming of demonstration runs.
- The TVS coordinator will define the switch positions between each camera after the full-length demonstration run in consultation with National Federations in the TVS room. Once decided this switch plan must remain the same during the relevant phase of the competition.

17. Athlete's video and photo for TV graphics and sport presentation

- For the 2019 season, the ICF is planning to shoot a short video (8s without sound) of each athlete to be used during final phases.
- A detailed schedule will be sent to all team leaders with the list of athletes requested.
- The ICF requests the outstanding athletes to attend this short shooting session (maximum 2 minutes) with the national uniform on Thursday following the provided schedule in the media tent aside the TVS tent.

18. Key areas during competition

See venue map attached in appendix 1

A. Enquiry / Protest desk

- The Enquiry desk is located in front of the OVR.

B. Equipment control

- Equipment Control is located next to the exit on the left side of the finish pool.
- Self-checking is open: Thursday 29 August from 8.45 to 17.00.
- Emergency self-checking: Equipment control will be open each day 1h before the 1st boat starts.
- There will be post competition control and random checking with all boats being checked during the Finals.

C. Medals ceremonies

- Location: see map in appendix 1
- Schedule: see competition schedule, after each session of final
- If your athlete is in a final, please bring their National Federation uniform to the equipment control area prior to the final (for Canoe Slalom and Extreme Canoe Slalom).

D. Doping control station

- The doping control station is located in the changing room in the ground floor of the main building.
- Athletes will be notified for Doping Control at the finish area.
