Registration for the event will be Open. Each National Federation will proceed to enter their athletes through the ICF registration system (SDP) https://icf.msl.es/icf/main.jsp

The Royal Spanish Canoeing Federation will proceed to check all registrations made by the different National Federations.

The National Federations will have to elaborate their own National Ranking with their athletes as in the event's multiple start lines paddlers will be seeded with the top athletes of each ranking in the first places and the rest in the following one

2.2.4- PAYMENT

3- COVID PROTOCOLS

3.1- PHYLOSOPHY

3.1.1- SCHEDULED ASSESSMENTS

The ICF in conjunction with the HOC will assess the current situation once a month leading up to the event and the month prior to the event, every week.

- 3.1.2- EARLY DETECTION SYSTEM
- 3.1.3- COORDINATION WITH THE LOCAL HEALTHCARE AUTHORITIES
- 3.1.4- UPDATES ON THE PROTOCOL
- 3.1.4.1 The protocol established on the venue will follow the guidelines which are in continuous development.

3.2- CONDITIONS

- 3.2.1- For accreditation, all athletes must show evidence of completion of a Covid test (PCR) with negative results 72hr to gain access to the Venue of the event.
- 3.2.2- Evidence must be provided so Access to the race venue is guaranteed.

3.3- ANTIGEN TESTING DURING THE EVENT

The Organization will have a medical team to perform Antigen Tests on accredited persons who have a stay of more than 5 days.

3.4- TESTING IN CASE OF AN EMERGENCY

3.4.1- WHEN?

The ICF will be enabled to test in case of possible cases at any times during the event period.

3.4.2- WHO NEEDS TO BE TESTED

- 3.4.2.1 Anybody that has had close contact with other positives.
- 3.4.2.2- Any team member of the positive case.

3.4.3- SAMPLES MANAGEMENT AND ANALYSIS

- 3.4.3.1 The HOC will provide a solution.
- 3.4.3.2- The protocol will be activated by the ICF.
- 3.4.3.3- The covid manager will be in close communications with the Chief Medical Officer at the ICF.

3.4.4- ¿WHAT KIND OF TEST MUST BE MADE?

- 3.4.4.1 PCR for the person and possible positive cases.
- 3.4.4.2- Antigen or PCR test in case of a positive case in a broader population sample.

3.5- TESTING, TRACING AND ISOLATION DURING THE EVENT PERIOD

- 3.5.1 In case of a positive test or suspicion:
 - 3.5.1.1 Define a clear process for each group
 - 3.5.1.1.1 National Federation Members:
 - One case in a team, immediate isolation for the whole team.
 - Assessment of needed actions with local health authorities & ICF medical committee representative:
 - All members must be tested and if negative, athletes can compete but will be restricted to minimal movements (special bubble for contact people with negative tests)
 - 3.5.1.1.2- Other people from ICF, HOC, ITOs, Media, security, volunteers:
 - Immediate isolation and testing for all contact people.
 - Assessment of needed actions with local health authorities & ICF medical committee representative.
 - If negative result, they can operate but will be restricted to minimal movements
 - 3.5.1.1.3- All expenses for isolation or needed quarantine must be paid by the concerned entity.

3.6- DEPARTURE TEST

- 3.6.1 Mandatory if an accreditated person is travelling directly to another competition.
- 3.6.2- Non-mandatory when an accredited person is returning home or travelling to a place where a negative test is not required.
- 3.6.3- Service organised by the HOC and paid by the participant.

3.7- COVID VACCINATION

The ICF recommends to all people to be vaccinated as soon as possible.

However, the vaccination will not remove any ICF countermeasures. There is no guarantee that vaccination eliminates virus transmission.

4- PARTICIPATION FEE

Participation fee will be 120€ per athlete and competition.














8- RACE VENUE

The Islate de la Fermina is an iconic landmark of the Island of Lanzarote. Designed in the early 1970's by the local artist Cesar Manrique, alongside the Parque Islas Canarias these will be the main race HQ and location of the event itself.
