



**Category A:**

Four-day ticket DKK 449 / EUR 60

On these stands you will sit so close to the water that you can almost touch the athletes as they paddle by.

**Category B:**

Four-day ticket DKK 349 / EUR 47

On these natural stands you will have an excellent view of the entire Regatta Course.

**Category C:**

Four-day ticket DKK 249 / EUR 34

This area will mainly be for new fans that are mostly interested in the side-activities.

# FANS AND FRIENDS

The organizers of the 2021 ICF Canoe Sprint and Paracanoe World Championships, Denmark are looking forward to welcoming all fans, families, and spectators to the Danish National Regatta Course Lake Bagsvaerd, Copenhagen, September 15-19 2021.

We have confirmation from the Danish Government that we can welcome at least seated spectators per day with no restrictions.

We will make sure that you feel safe with plenty of room for each spectator.

Together with our partner, Travel Sense, we are offering hotel packages for fans and media. Please refer to any travel registration in your home country.

All hotels are located in downtown Copenhagen, in walking distance from the Central Train Station. Only 13 minutes by train from the Airport to the Central Station and only 28 minutes by train from the Central Station to the Regatta Course.

The neighbourhood of the hotels has a bustling shopping area that is teeming with cool cafes, great restaurants, and trendy bars. Also, don't forget the

Meatpacking District Kødbyen, which is just a block away. The hotels are close to Istedgade, which is home to many designer shops, of course close to the old amusement park, Tivoli, as well as the City Hall Square.

## CHOOSE THE BEST WAY TO GO SIGHTSEEING: BY KAYAK.

We will begin our journey at Kayak Republic at Knippelsbro, drifting by the National Bank, heading towards lively and colorful Nyhavn, seeing the Opera House and eventually entering the canals of historical Christianshavn.

The Black Diamond welcomes us into Copenhagen's intimate canals again. We then head towards Christiansborg through Frederiksholms canal, paddling under beautiful bridges and finding the secret underwater sculpture, Agnete og Havmanden.

Other features shown on each athlete's biography on the ICF website:

**National federation link** - this logo is the same one as used on the national federation page, and will link an interested fan to more information about your federation.

**Photo** - this is added directly onto the website by the ICF.

**News** - this tab will appear if the athlete has been mentioned in any news story on the ICF website. News stories now also contain mouse-over photo previews of all mentioned athletes and a link to their biography.

**Multimedia** - this tab appears when the athlete has been tagged in a relevant video or photo (excluding competition footage).

**Footage** - this shows all competition footage of the athlete where they have been tagged since 2017. The link goes directly to the start of the athlete's race.

**Results** - these are shown for world cups and world championships since 2013, wherever possible. Please note that some discipline results have not yet been added to the database.

# COVID-19

Denmark is at a point in the pandemic where we are opening up again. 50% of the adult population has received the first shot of the vaccination. The Danish Government has announced a full opening of Denmark by the end of July where everyone over 50 years old will be fully vaccinated. We have a close collaboration with the Danish authorities and the Danish National Health Organization to ensure that we take the correct measures when setting up the event site, the accommodation, and the transportation for the 2021 ICF Canoe Sprint and Paracanoe World Championships, Denmark.

We assure you that we will be in line with recommendations and restrictions from WHO, the Danish Government, and ICF.

As mentioned in the beginning of this Bulletin 3, we are pleading with you to start the hotel registration process as soon as possible as this will help us a lot in the planning of a Covid-19 free event. We will update the website with further information for both athletes and spectators.


