PRE-COMPETITION TRAINING PERIOD

OFFICIAL TRAINING PERIOD

The official training for the competition starts on 2 May and ends on 5 May after the morning session. The water cost of the official training and competition period is covered by the HOC.

Expect two (non-exclusive) training slots for each federation per day, except on 5 May, when one (non-exclusive) training slot will be available for each NF.

COMPETITIONS

The Pan American Championships and Canadian Team Trials will begin on Friday, 6 May and conclude on Saturday, 7 May. The USA Team Trials will begin on Friday, 6 May and conclude on Sunday, 8 May. The competition schedule for the entire event will be published after the close of the Nominal Entry period.

COMPETITION RULES

2022 PAN AMERICAN CANOE SLALOM CHAMPIONSHIPS will be run in accordance with ICF Canoe Slalom Competition Rules and COPAC Canoe Slalom Competition Rules (race format and advancements). Boat stickers are mandatory for international races.

ACCREDITATION

Accreditation (credentials) will be required to access the venue and will be available at Accreditation entry point for registered athletes, coaches and team leaders. Accreditation and race information will be headquartered in the RIVERSPORT Whitewater Center.

The registration fee is \$125 USD per Athlete (Aa), Team Leader (AC), Technical Staff (Ao), Medical Staff (Am), and includes a commemorative T-shirt and celebration meal after the completion of the PAN AMERICAN CANOE SLALOM CHAMPIONSHIPS.

National Federations must pay registration fees for their athletes before 2 May. Late payment will be accepted until 5 May; however, the HOC will collect a \$20 late fee per athlete after 2 May.

NIE Waivers for foreign athletes and staff

The previous US waiver process ended on 8 November 2021 when a requirement of full vaccination against COVID-19 came into effect for all foreign nationals entering the US.

At this time all foreign nationals entering the US are required to present the following:

- Passport
- Visa or ESTA: If you have any questions regarding entry into the U.S., obtaining a Visa or if you need a letter, please reach out as soon as possible to tadelberg@americancanoe.org
- Negative COVID test taken within 1 day of travel (antigen tests are accepted)
- Proof of full vaccination against COVID-19 or proof of exception from the requirement
