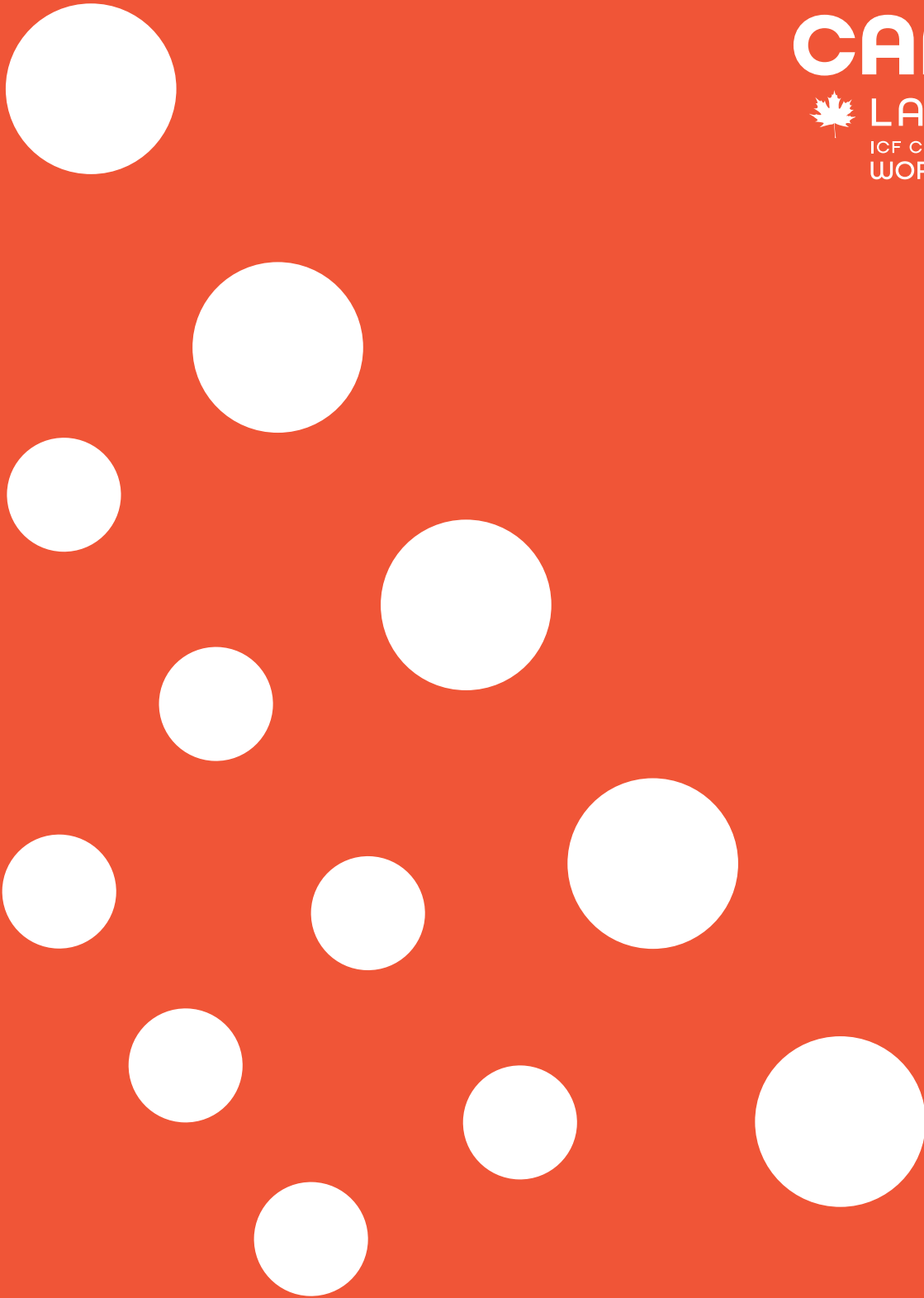

SCHEDULE

Access period	July 30–August 7, 2022

TEAM LEADERS MEETING

The pre-event Team Leader's meeting will take place on August 2, 2022. This meeting will be held virtually.



PARACANOE ATHLETE CLASSIFICATION

Athletes with one of the following statuses are required to pass the classification before any competition:

- "REVIEW Status with a Fixed Review Date" before the competition
- "REVIEW Status" or
- "New Status"

The classification schedule will be organized through a classification poll, through which the team will be able to choose a preferred date for the athlete's classification. Selected preferred dates are not guaranteed, but we do our best effort to accommodate everyone. **The poll will be open from July 4–8, and will be communicated by email and posted on the Paracanoë page of the ICF website.**

The classification evaluations will occur during three days, from July 30–August 1, 2022.

The detailed schedule will be communicated to each Team Leader / NF / NPC a few days after the classification pool has closed.

For each athlete who requires classification, the following documents must be uploaded using the classification upload platform by the following dates:

- **Medical diagnosis documents must be uploaded by July 8, 2022**
 - Paracanoë Athlete Certificate of Diagnosis
 - Athlete Diagnosis Form
 - Any/all other supporting medical documentation

(NF's/NPC's are responsible for submitting all information considered necessary to support their athlete. Unclear and/or inconsistent documentation may have a consequence on correct athlete classification.)

- **All other classification documents must be uploaded by July 15, 2022**
 - Declaration of Medical Complications and Emergency Measures
 - Paracanoë Athlete Information and Consent
 - Strapping waiver - this document will be valid for the whole 2022 season
 - PFD waiver - this document will be valid for the whole 2022 season

For every paracanoë athlete competing, the following documents must be uploaded by the following dates:

- Strapping and PFD waivers by **July 15, 2022**
- Equipment passport by **July 30, 2022**

ACCOMMODATIONS

Canoe'22 and Tournkey Travel have provided several accommodation options for the 2022 ICF Canoe Sprint & Paracanoe World Championships.
