

The lake is steeped in history and has provided opportunities for sprint paddlers since 1904, with the creation of the lake's oldest club, Banook Canoe Club. Lined with a boardwalk adjacent to the racing course, Lake Banook provides the ultimate spectator experience—perfect for the local community whose passion for canoeing spans over a century.

Equipped with a beautiful race course and modern sports facilities, Lake Banook regularly serves as a hub for elite training programs, local events and national competitions. The Canoe '22 team recognizes that Panuk (Lake Banook) is located in Mi'kma'ki, the ancestral and traditional territory of the Mi'kmaq people. We acknowledge them as the past, present and future caretakers of this land, and we are grateful for the opportunity to further educate the world on Indigenous culture and the history of both Punamu'kwati'jk (Dartmouth), and the gwitn (canoe). Throughout this document, we will continue to recognize the traditional Mi'kmaw place names.

# **ABOUT DARTMOUTH (PUNAMU'KWATI'JK)**

Affectionately known as the "City of Lakes",
Dartmouth, Nova Scotia contains 23 distinctive
lakes, each with their own unique natural features
and surroundings. Dartmouth is home to four of
Nova Scotia's eight sprint canoe clubs, also serving
as a training hub for national team athletes.

Located just across the harbour from Halifax's bustling core, Dartmouth offers a different experience entirely—combining modern shops, eateries and cafés with forests, trails and waterways. With only minutes of travel, visitors can trade-in the small but mighty downtown area for the quiet and calm of Dartmouth's parks and beaches.

# **ABOUT LAKE BANOOK (PANUK)**

Lake Banook is rich in both sprint canoe history and modern usage. It is a natural freshwater lake, which is part of a system of lakes and canals that connect the Halifax Harbour to the Bay of Fundy—a distance that spans over 114 km.

Here, you'll find three separate canoe clubs— Mic Mac, Senobe and Banook. Each has its own stories, histories and champions, dating back to the creation of the Banook Canoe Club in 1904. The lake frequently plays host to provincial, national and international competitions for various age groups and abilities, most notably the World Junior Canoe Sprint Championships in 1989, the World Marathon Canoe Championships in 2001 and the Senior World Canoe Sprint Championships in 1997 and 2009.



# **FACILITIES**

The competition racecourse is situated on Lake Banook (Panuk), a naturally occurring lake that plays home to three separate canoe clubs. Canoe '22's athletes' village, disembarkment, medal presentations and festival are centred around the finish area at the base of the lake, creating the electrifying environment appropriate for the 2022 ICF Canoe Sprint and Paracanoe World Championships.

# TALENT IDENTIFICATION PROGRAM

The TIP program is set out to create policies for countries and disciplines of canoeing that need support for sustainable growth, and to encourage younger athletes from developing countries who have been identified as having the potential to achieve international results. We are currently working with ICF on the details of this training camp leading up to the World Championships in Dartmouth. ### **BOAT TRANSFER**

Boat transfers will be provided by Prowave Boat & Coach Service, the official logistics partner of the ICF. Boats will be collected in Kassel, Germany up until **July 5, 2022**. There is also an option to collect boats at the second 2022 Sprint Canoe World Cup in Poznan, Poland on **May 29, 2022**.

### This service will include:

- Boat transport in sea freight containers from Kassel, Germany to Dartmouth, Canada
- Boat loading and lashing services to ensure safe transport in both directions
- All customs clearance paperwork
- Transport insurance
- Guaranteed timing

Boats will be made available in Dartmouth by **July 26, 2022** and will be collected after the completion of the event on **August 7, 2022**. For customs reasons, all boats must be shipped back to Germany in the same containers in which they arrived. They will be made available for pickup in Kassel after **August 30, 2022**, where boats will be safely stored until pickup or delivery.

### Boat transport prices are calculated on a per boat basis, with pricing as follows:

- K1/C1/K2/C2: €300 per boat
- K4 / C4: €350 per boat
- Accessories like bicycles, paddles, etc., can be added for a fee on a case-by-case basis

### ATHLETE NAME AND COUNTRY CODE STICKERS

The athlete's name sticker must be applied on all boats for ICF Canoe Sprint and Paracanoe competitions. In order for the canoes and kayaks to be presented in a standard manner, the name stickers must be positioned at the same point on every boat. The country code sticker will be applied on all boats and at the same place for each ICF Canoe Sprint competition. The stickers will be checked at the Boat Control. It is the participating National Federations' responsibility to provide the stickers to their athletes. Please use the template provided by the ICF with the correct sizes and font.

**NEW from 2022:** Athlete names stickers have been modified to match the re-formatted TV graphics. The last name is now placed after the initial of first name.

### **VISA INFORMATION**

Depending on your citizenship, visitors to Canada may require a visa to enter the country. Processing times for visa applications vary depending on the visa office and the time of the year. Participants are encouraged to check the processing times calculator for guidance, but it is recommended to apply approximately 12 weeks in advance of their departure date to ensure they receive the visa in time for the start of the event. Federations can check to see if they require a visa through this link. Should you or your participants require a visa, a letter of invitation from the Canoe '22 Society will be provided upon request in support of your application.

Please note that given the current travel restrictions, we ask that you continue to monitor the Immigration, Refugee, and Citizenship Canada (IRCC) website for COVID-19 updates.

### **MEDICAL CARE AND INSURANCE**

Canoe '22 asks that all participants of the World Championship take out a medical insurance policy in their respective country. All costs above the regular first aid and ambulance services are to be covered by this medical insurance policy. Canoe '22 will not cover any expenses in connection with hospital treatment.

All billing will be prepared and managed by Tournkey Travel. Please note that common taxes you could see included on your invoice include:

- HST (Harmonized Sales Tax): a tax implemented on all good and services by the federal government and PST (Provincial Sales Tax): taxes collected and remitted to the provincial government for the sale of goods and services - 15% combined
- DMF (Destination Management Fund) / MAT (Municipal Accommodation Tax): fees collected and remitted to destination marketing organizations to promote and market the destination - 2%

Presented with your invoice will be terms and conditions for cancellation or changes made to your bookings. **Bookings will not be considered confirmed until payment is received.** 

Federations will have the following mechanisms to complete payments:

- Wire transfers (subject to a \$25 administration fee)

# **CATEGORY 1**

### **DALHOUSIE UNIVERSITY**

Accommodations in Dalhousie University Residences are designated to teams and support staff only.

Risley Hall and LeMarchant Place are located in close proximity on the same section of LeMarchant Street on Dalhousie's campus for those teams that may book rooms in both buildings.

### **Accessibility**

Canoe '22 has secured a limited number of wheelchair accessible rooms at our Dalhousie location in both Risley Hall and LeMarchant Place. Allocation of these rooms will be designated to paracanoe athletes requiring wheelchair access or equivalent. All beds in either building may be adjusted to accommodate preferred/required heights, and LeMarchant Place suites offer additional living space for maneuvering.
