HOST ORGANISING COMMITTEE

Italian Canoe Kayak Federation. The first organisational nucleus of Italian canoeing was established in 1935 in Milan with the foundation in Milan of the Gruppo Milanese della Canoa (GMP or Milan Canoeing Group) (and the following year an Italian canoeist took part in the Berlin Olympic Games). On 17 February 1936 a circular from Reale Federazione Italiana di Canottaggio (Royal Rowing Federation) established a Canoeing Section. On 6 March 1939 the GMP changed its name into Gruppo Italiano Canoa (GIC or Italian Canoeing Group) with headquarters in Milan (Galleria Vittorio Emanuele, 92). On 8 February 1942 group, under the chairmanship of Gino Tosti di Valminuta, was transferred to Rome, where it continued to be incorporated within Federcanottaggio (Rowing Federation) (Secretary Giordano B. Fabjan). On 24 November 1973 the Commissione Italiana Canoa (CIC or Italian Canoeing Commission), which had adhered on 30 November 1982, finally changed to Federazione Italiana Canoa Kayak (FICK or Italian Canoe Kayak Federation). FICK was then recognised by CONI as "effective" on 30 April 1987. On 11 December 1992, FICK promoted the constitution in Rome of the European Canoeing Association.

IDROSCALO REGATTA COURSE

The Idroscalo of Milan is an artificial lake in the metropolitan city of Milan, covering an area of 1.6 km². It is fed by the groundwater of the Lambro River and is located between the municipalities of Peschiera Borromeo and Segrate, in a zone not far from Linate Airport. Originally built as a water airport in the late 1920s—a function that inspired its name—the Idroscalo lost its commercial relevance with the decline of seaplane transport. Over time, it transformed into a vibrant hub for recreational and sports activities. In 2025, Idroscalo will mark the 90th anniversary of the first canoeing competition held there in 1935. Since 1999, the Idroscalo of Milan has hosted many international events, most recently the 2015 Canoe Sprint World Championships and the ECA Canoe Polo Cup in 2018.

The Idroscalo basin is highly appreciated for its conformation and technical characteristics: the flat bottom and homogeneous wind flows guarantee equal racing conditions for all athletes. Other strengths include: the pre-existence of the structures necessary for the organization and conduct of races (e.g., finish tower, grandstands, offices), facilities, infrastructures, the large hotel capacity of the area, excellent transport connections, and above all, the unique opportunity to host the world event in an exceptional setting like Milan.





REACHING IDROSCALO DI MILANO

Idroscalo di Milano is a popular recreational area in Milan, Italy.

BY AIRPLANE

If you're arriving by air, here's how to get there from the city's airports:

Milan Linate Airport: Linate is the most convenient airport to reach Idroscalo. **Travel time**: Approximately 15-20 minutes by car.

Milan Malpensa Airport: Malpensa is a larger international airport, but it's farther from Idroscalo. **Travel time**: Approximately 45-60 minutes by car, depending on traffic.

Bergamo Orio al Serio Airport: Bergamo Orio al Serio is a budget airline hub, but it's the farthest from Idroscalo. **Travel time**: Approximately 60-75 minutes by car, depending on traffic.

BY CAR

The Idroscalo di Milano is easily accessible by car. Here are the main routes to follow:

- **From the city center**: Follow the directions to Viale Forlanini, then take SP 15/B "Paullese" towards Melzo or Peschiera Borromeo. Signs for the Idroscalo will guide you.
- From the Tangenziale Est: Take exit 6 for Linate Airport/Idroscalo. Follow Viale Forlanini and then SP 15/B "Paullese" as indicated above.

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION


Public transportation from Idroscalo to City Centre: Idroscalo has never been closer to the heart of Milan! Thanks to the new M4 metro line, connecting Linate Airport to the city center, reaching the metropolis from this green oasis is a breeze. In just 15 minutes, you can go from the tranquility of the artificial lake to the hustle and bustle of the city. Milan has a good public transportation system. Consider using buses or the metro for a cost-effective option. Apps like Google Maps or Waze can provide real-time traffic updates and help you find the best route. WEATHER

Daily high temperatures decrease by 3°C, from 30°C to 27°C, rarely falling below 23°C or exceeding 33°C. Daily low temperatures decrease by 2°C, from 19°C to 17°C, rarely falling below 14°C or exceeding 22°C. For reference, on July 26, the hottest day of the year, temperatures in Milan typically range from 19°C to 30°C, while on January 12, the coldest day of the year, they range from -1°C to 6°C.

The figure below shows you a compact characterization of the hourly average temperatures for the quarter of the year centered on August.







ACCOMMODATION PACKAGES

The accommodation package fee includes the following services:

PARTICIPATION FEE

In case your accommodation has been booked independently and NOT through the Host Organising Committee, you are required to pay a participation fee of 30 EUR/person/day from the day of your arrival. This fee includes basic services, **but from this year does NOT include lunch at the Regatta Course.**

LUNCH

National teams with individual hotel reservations can add lunch at the Regatta Course for 18 EUR / meal / person. Please note that orders are accepted until 15th July and purchases are subject to a 100% cancellation fee after this deadline.

*Please note that NOT include shuttle bus service to and from the regatta course.



TERMS OF PAYMENT

BOOKING AND PAYMENT OPTIONS:

After the booking has been confirmed by the HOC, an invoice will be issued for 40% of the total amount. The booking will be considered provisional until the amount has been credited to our bank account. Therefore, the Organizing Committee reserves the right to modify or cancel the booking until that time.

BOOKING CONFIRMATION:

The booking will be definitively confirmed upon receipt of the 40% payment. To speed up the confirmation process, please send a copy of the bank transfer receipt to accommodation@canoemilan2025.com.

BALANCE AND INVOICING:

The Organizing Committee will then send an updated proforma invoice showing the payments credited to our account. The booking remains provisional until the full amount due has been received. Once the balance has been received, the booking will be definitively confirmed.

CANCELLATION TERMS

Should you cancel or modify your hotel booking, a charge will be made equivalent to any loss suffered by the Organising Committee, as itemised below. The amount of the cancellation fee will be calculated as a percent of the accommodation package fee according to the following period of notice given:

A medical centre will operate at the regatta course with ambulance and first aid. The costs above the regular first aid, ambulance and physiotherapeutic services are to be covered by the athletes own medical insurance policy. The Organising Committee is not responsible for covering your expenses in connection with hospital treatment, dental treatment or any other medical treatment.
