REPUBILC OF POLAND



The Republic of Poland is a country located in Central Europe, bordered by Germany to the west; the Czech Republic and Slovakia to the south; Ukraine and Belarus to the east; and the Baltic Sea. The total area of Poland is 312,679 square kilometers (120,726 sq mi). With a population of over 38.5 million people, Poland is a member of the European Union and Schengen Area.

Poland is a country of representative democracy and according to the Global Peace Index ranks in the top 20 percent of the most peaceful countries in the world. President, elected by popular vote every five years, is the head of the country. Prime minister, elected every four years, is the head of government. In 1999 Poland was divided into 16 voivodeships, 380 poviats, and 2478 communes.

ABOUT POZNAN



The fifth largest city in Poland, is situated in the western part of the country on the Warta River. The region is called Wielkopolska (Great Poland). It is rich in lakes, woods and fields adorned with monuments uncovering over 1000 years of Polish history.

Located at a cross-roads for both road and railway networks, Poznan is halfway between Berlin and Warsaw. Both these capitals can be reached by a EuroCity train within three hours. With a population of over 600 000 inhabitants, not only is it a vital centre of Polish trade, culture, industry and agriculture, but also an exciting spot to visit for its own sake, fully deserving to be included in tourist itineraries.

Economically, Poznan and the surrounding region is, by any standard, one of the best developed parts of the country. It is now undergoing fast economic growth, which can be attributed to the character of the local people, generally described as being hard-working and industrious. The city is proud of its International Fair, first launched in 1921, a major business venture.

The centre of the city is very compact and within a short walk one can find all the most important institutions and places of interest. Of particular interest are the Old Market Square with its Renaissance Town Hall and the Ostrow Tumski island with its Gothic Cathedral. From the large number of museums, especially worth seeing are the Museum of Musical Instruments - one of the largest of its kind in Europe, the Museum of Decorative Arts and the National Museum with its gallery of painting.

MALTA REGATTA COURSE HISTORY



The history of the regatta course on Lake Malta dates back to 1917, when a group of patriotic Poznań residents announced a competition for a sports center for youth. It was no coincidence that the Malta area was chosen – it was here, during the Prussian occupation, that the youth of Poznań gathered to practice various sports under the guidance of "Sokół" instructors. Unfortunately, it took nearly 35 years for this vision to become a reality. In 1952, the Malta hosted large international rowing and canoeing regattas, held as part of the Youth and Student Festival.

The venue immediately gained recognition, primarily due to its unique and almost perfect location – the regatta basin is situated nearly in the city center, on the edge of expansive green areas. Numerous hotels and student dormitories ensure a variety of accommodation and dining options, and Poznań, as a city known for traditional international fairs, offers excellent transport connections to all of Europe and the world.

As the regatta course eventually no longer met international standards for holding rowing and canoeing competitions, a major modernization was carried out between 1981 and 1990, including deepening the entire lake, reinforcing the shores, and building new facilities to support the course. This modernization was made possible thanks to the persistence of a small group of activists, led by the then-President of the City of Poznań, Andrzej Wituski.







The plans were executed based on the concept, designs, and supervision of a former athlete – a rower from the Academic Sports Association in Poznań, a Polish Rowing Champion – architect Klemens Mikuła. His years of experience as a competitive rower, who competed on various courses and under different conditions, are particularly evident in the functionality and equipment of the facilities for athletes, judges, and course staff. It is no surprise, then, that the venue is not only beautiful but, above all, highly functional today.





AWARDING CEREMONY

During the medal ceremonies at the 2025 ICF Canoe Sprint and Paracanie World Cup, national **anthems will not be performed**.

Instead, the anthem of the International Canoe Federation will be played to accompany the ceremonies.

Athletes should wear their official team uniforms or competition uniforms and footwear must be worn (barefoot is not allowed).

Athletes may not wear hats or headgear and no sunglasses are allowed throughout the Ceremony.




