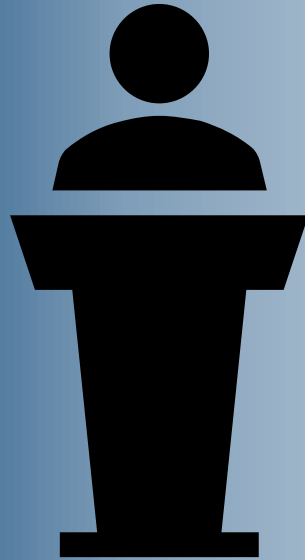

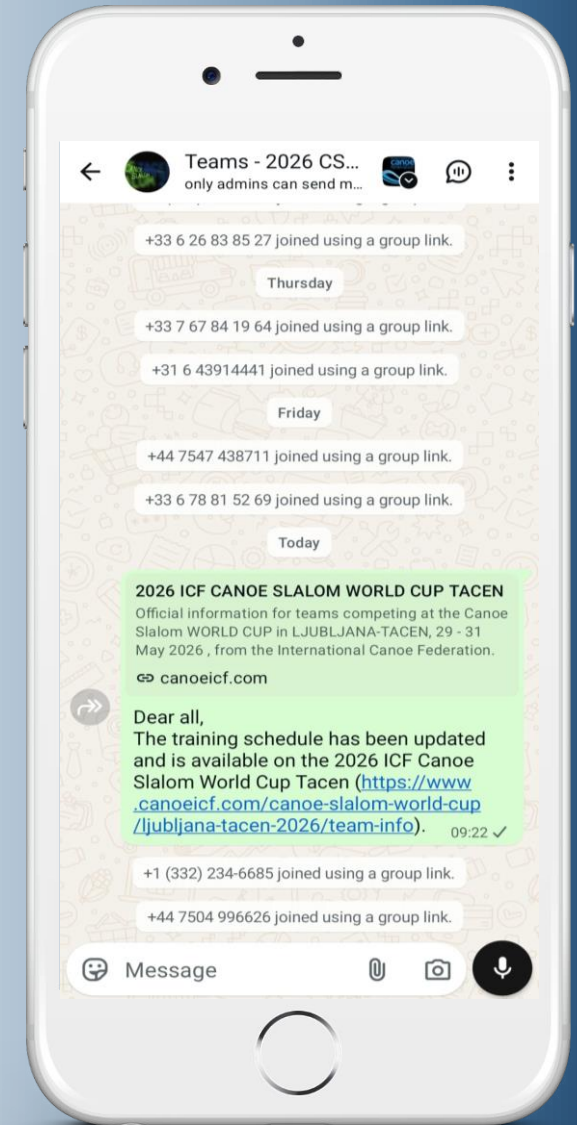

NF AREA

- The NF Tent area is in the main car park
- **Reasonably sized extra tents can be installed in the NF area.**
- **Remember power is limited!**
- NF parking is located adjacent to the team tent area and behind the sports club
- **Parking passes will be distributed through the Sport Info Office.**
- The NF area is accessible from Monday 8 June to Sunday 14 June, 24 hours/day



EQUIPMENT CONTROL

- **Location:** next to the takeout in the finish pool
- **Self-checking:** Thursday 11th June from 08:00 to 18:00
- **Timing on competition days:** open 1h before the 1st boat starts.
- **Reminders:**
 - **CSL fins** – if metal showing ensure no sharp edges
 - **Extra weights** – must be fixed in the boat
 - **Canoe & Kayak events and Kayak Cross Individual:** random post competition control
 - **Kayak Cross Elimination:** pre-competition checking in the pre-start area



KISS & CRY

- **Location:**
 - Above the steps from the finish pool on river left
- **For Canoe and Kayak finals:**
 - Provisional **top 3**
 - In bib and competition gear
- **For Kayak Cross Individual:**
 - Provisional **top 3 only for the last 10 minutes**
 - In number bib and competition gear (warm clothes accepted). Competition bibs will be redistributed if needed.
- **For Kayak Cross Elimination:**
 - Provisional **Top 3**
 - In colour bib and competition gear



MEDAL CEREMONIES

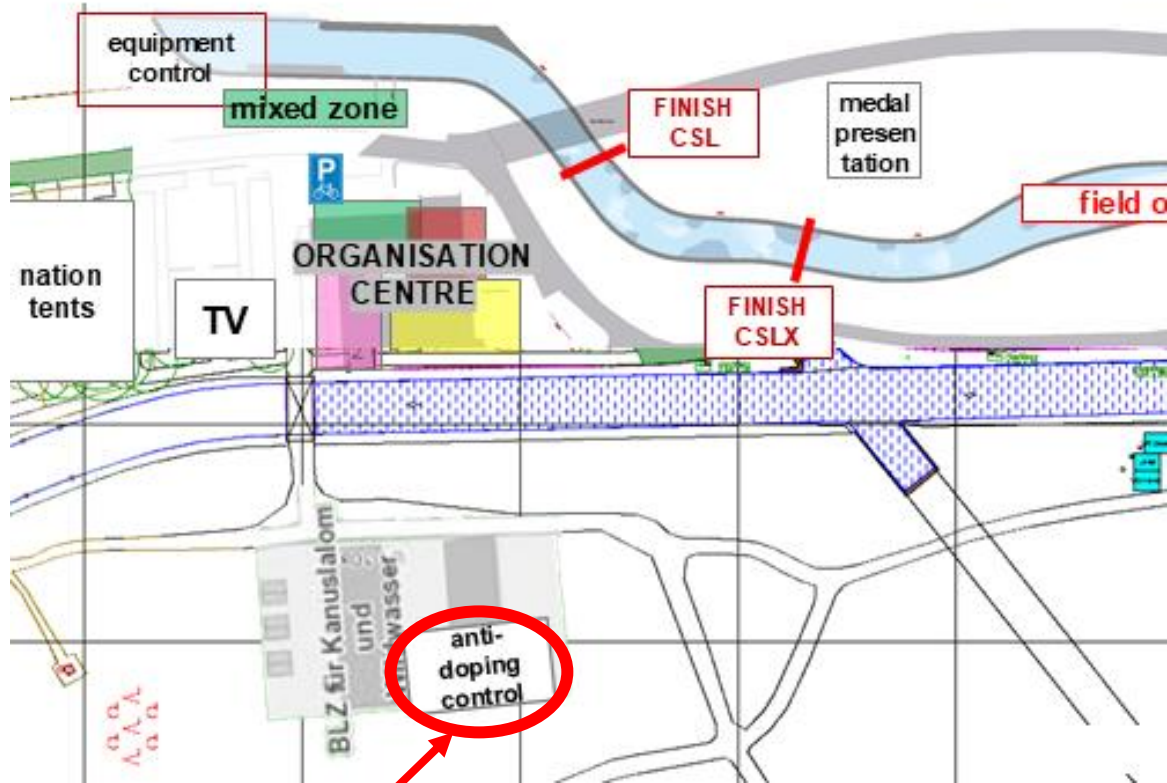
- **Location:** award area in the middle of the course, river right
- **Schedule:** refer to the competition schedule
 - For canoe, kayak and kayak cross events: after each session of finals
 - For Kayak Cross Individual: after the run of the event
- **Kayak Cross Individual & Kayak Cross Elimination: in competition gear (with bib)**
- Kayak Cross Individual **will not** involve Team Leaders or play anthems, raise flags

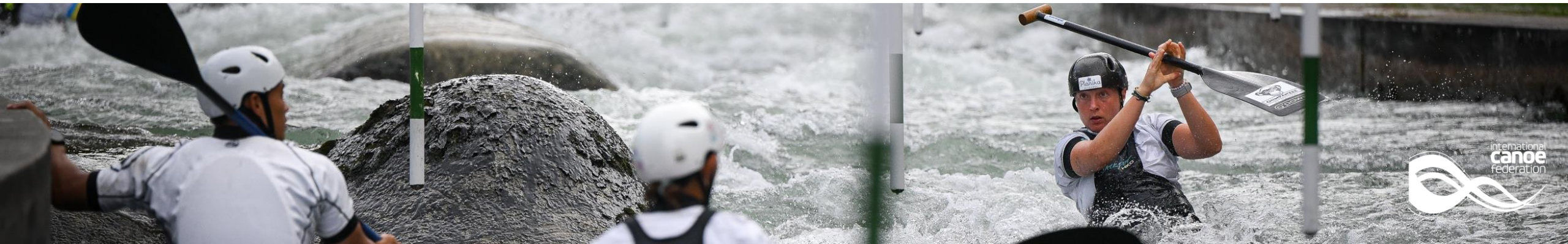

OFFICIAL TRAINING SCHEDULE

- Canoe slalom training sessions: from Monday to Thursday, exact timings and updates, available on [2026 ICF Canoe Slalom World Cup Augsburg – Team Info](#).

For the next competitions, for special request, please send an email to ICF Technical manager (Manon – manon.bocquet@canoeicf.sport) – should be sent before numerical entries' deadline.

- **Kayak Cross training sessions on Saturday** will now be split one session WX1 and two sessions of MX1 – refer to schedule for the groups.
- As at every competition, athletes competing exclusively in Kayak Cross are not permitted to participate in the slalom training sessions (including forerunner and free sessions). It also applies to canoe slalom athletes not competing in kayak cross, they are not permitted to participate in Kayak Cross training sessions.



COMPETITION SCHEDULE

- The course is closed following the end of official training (Thursday 11.06.2026 at 19:30) until the end of the competition – except for the Kayak Cross free sessions on Saturday and Sunday.
- The competition schedule version 3 will be available on the 2026 ICF Canoe Slalom World Cup Augsburg – Team Info and on spread on the WhatsApp group on Thursday 11.06.2026 by 10:00am.

BIB DISTRIBUTION

Canoe Slalom competition bibs:

- Competition bibs: available at the **Sport Info Office from 14:00 on Thursday 11/06.**
- Deposit of **50€ - cash only.**
- CSL competition bibs must be returned to the Sport Information Office following the competition for the return of the deposit.

Kayak Cross bibs:

- For **Kayak Cross Individual**, bibs will be available at the **Sport Info office from 14:00 on Thursday, 11/06.**
- Bibs will be collected at the end of the Kayak Cross Individual race.
- For **Kayak Cross Elimination**, the **number** and **colour bibs** will be distributed **at the pre-start area.**



CANOE & KAYAK EVENTS

Start procedure:

The starting boat must be facing upstream at the red handlebar in front of the partners' panel on river right

The beam line is on the edge of the first stopper.



CANOE & KAYAK EVENTS

Finish procedure

- The finish beam will be marked by a banner across the course, **just before the bridge**.
- For canoe & kayak events, all athletes must exit on the left side at the bottom of the course to pass through equipment control, kiss and cry and the mixed zone.



KAYAK CROSS EVENTS

Pre-start procedure

- River left at the junction on the road bridge
- Athletes may warm up upstream of the start bridge
- **Never cross under the bridge or paddle downstream of the warning banner**
- **During training if athletes cross under the bridge, the use of the ramp in the training session will stop immediately.**



KAYAK CROSS EVENTS

Start procedure

➤ Kayak Cross Individual

- Athletes start from **lane 2 (second from river right)**
- The start interval is **60 seconds**; athletes should get in their boat directly on the start gate, volunteers will assist if needed.

➤ Kayak Cross Elimination

- Athletes should be **settled in the start position on the ramp 90 seconds** before their start time.
- Then listen to the sports presentation where they will be introduced to spectators.



KAYAK CROSS EVENTS

Start position:

The athlete must start with both hands on the paddle, positioned alongside the kayak. The front hand must be placed over the middle of the boat on one side, in contact with the boat or the spraydeck.

Until the ramp starts to move, the paddle must remain behind the flap.

The Athlete must not move between the instruction “Ready” and the beep indicating the ramp is moving.



KAYAK CROSS EVENTS

Finish procedure

- The finish line is located just before the “corkscrew” feature
- For Kayak Cross (individual and eliminations phase), all athletes must exit on the left side at the bottom of the course to pass through the mixed zone (same as CSL)
- Kayak Cross Individual: the three first athletes must proceed to the Kiss and Cry area for the last ten athletes (last 10min).
- Kayak Cross: the winner must proceed to the Kiss & Cry.
- There will be a golf cart to bring the boats at the start.



KAYAK CROSS EVENTS

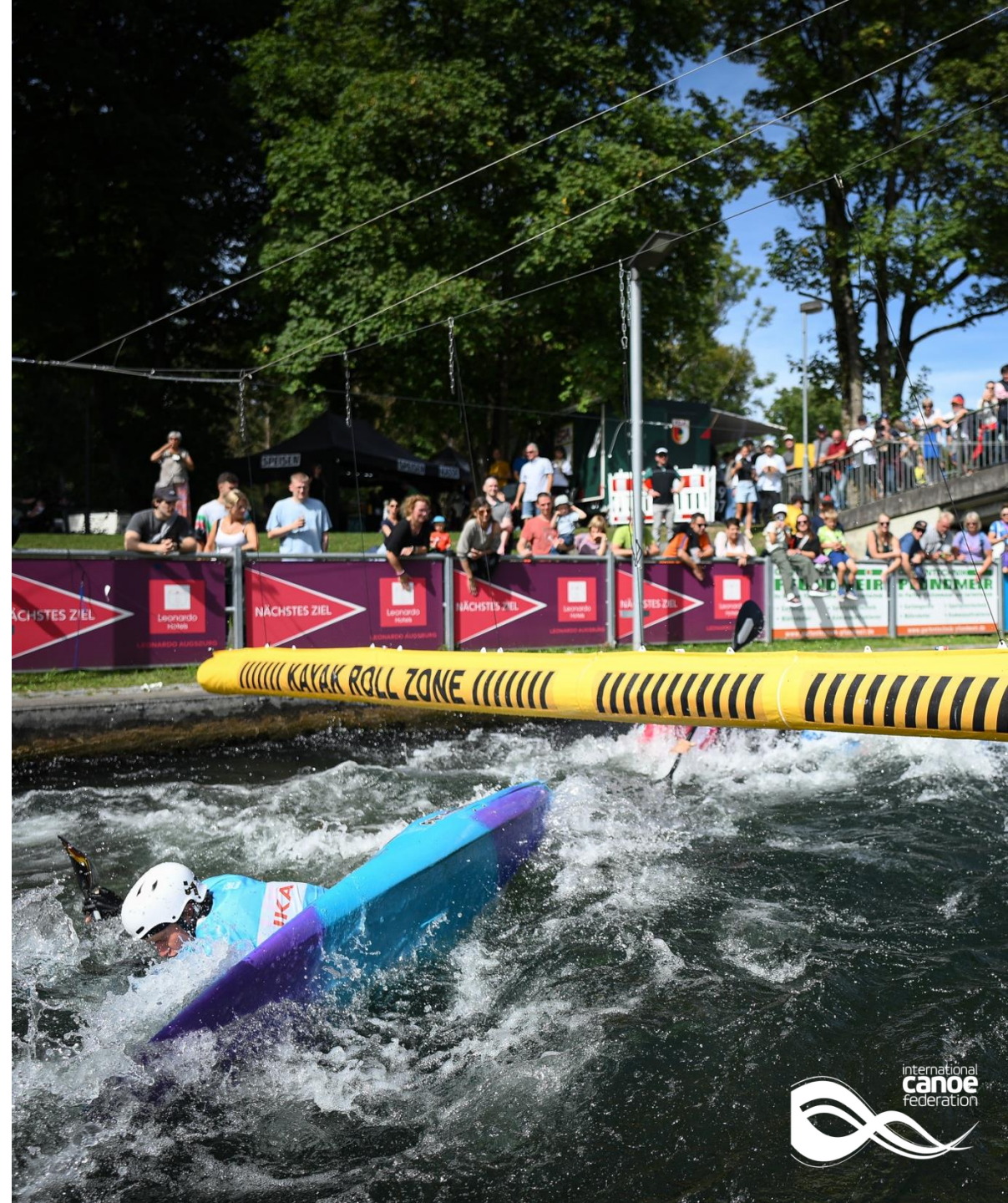
Roll barrier

For the **roll barrier**, the roll must be performed by going down on one side and coming up on the other.

During the execution of the roll, the boat must be underneath the barrier for at least one phase of the action.

Dangerous Contact

In the case of **dangerous contact**, the judges will decide the penalty and one or both boats may be penalized
