Parking - Parking Pass are needed for Sprint Course – please use only parking area which will be clearly marked, upstream from the PRESTART and downstream from the BOAT CONTROL area near exit.

The road between PRESTART and BOAT CONTROL area is reserved for rescue services and organisation

Access

Only accredited person are allowed to enter Prestart, Start and Finish Area Classic Start: there is no access to classic start!

All athletes receive their own individual Bib which is valid for all sprint runs as well as for classic competition. (Please take care that your athletes are on time at the start)
Team Bib will be collected after the sprint team run near the boat exit from some volunteers. There will be new Bibs for classic teams.

3. Competition

SPRINT

- all athletes needs to use official prestart area stairs from main road
- The Pre-starter will check the equipment
- Each boat goes to the releasing point on the call of the pre-starter
- Releasing Points see picture
- Start line (beam): marked by red/white stick Banner "Start"
- All boats will be released from raft
- Countdown (5,4,3,2,1,0)
- !!!! Startintervall Sprint individual heats 30 seconds
 Sprint individual Finals 45 seconds
 Sprint Teams I minute
- Interval between categories 3 minutes
- All boats need to go directly from releasing point to the beam without any stroke backwards or without any turn - otherwise the boat will be disqualified!
- Finish line (beam): marked by red/white stick Banner "Finish"
- Exit and boat control: stairs 200 meters behind finish on left bank
- Competitors have to stay at Boat Control Judge disposal. If the boat control judge
 gives his permission athletes are allowed to continue on river but on their own risk.

Classic

- all athletes needs to use official prestart area Vrbas Kamp
- The Pre-starter will check the equipment
- Each boat goes to the releasing point in time (To reach the startline in time is your own risk, there will be a clock at the pre start as well as the start)
- Releasing Points see picture
- Start line (beam): marked by red/white stick Banner "Start"
- All boats will be released from raft
- Countdown (5,4,3,2,1,0)
- !!!! Startintervall Classic individual I minute
 Classic Teams 2 minutes
- Interval between categories 3 minutes
- All boats need to go directly from releasing point to the beam without any stroke backwards or without any turn - otherwise the boat will be disqualified!
- Finish line (beam): marked by red/white stick Banner "Finish" 10 Meters before Bridge
- Exit and boat control: stairs 200 meters behind finish on right bank, please do not leave your equipment on the grass of the private ground
- Competitors have to stay at Boat Control Judge disposal. If the boat control judge gives his permission athletes are allowed to continue on river but on their own risk.

Results - Protest office - Inquiry - Protest fee

The results table is close to the finish line. Sprint- tent near finish line; Classic- parking area close to school

The protest fee is Euro 75,--. The Chief Judge will accept a protest from a Team Leader ONLY upon receipt of a deposit of 75 Euros, or the equivalent in the currency. The deposit is returned if the protest is upheld. If the protest is not upheld, or the Team Manager withdraws the protest, the deposit is forfeited to the Organising Committee of the competition.
