## 12. Bib Distribution

### A. Canoe Slalom Events

- Training bibs must be returned to the race office before competition bibs will be distributed.
- CSL Competition bibs will be available from the race office between 15:00 - 17:00 on the 05.07.2018.
- A bib deposit of 100 euro per nation is required on collection of the bibs.
- CSL Competition bibs must be returned to the race office following the competition for the return of the deposit.
- The bibs are allocated in the following way:

### B. Extreme Canoe Slalom Events

- For CSLX time trials bibs will be available from the race office between 11:00 – 13:00 on the 05.07.2018.
- For CSLX final phases bibs will be distributed in the start area on the right bank behind the ramp.

## 13. CSL - Start and Finish location and procedures

### A. Start position



### B. Pre start procedure

- Athletes will be responsible for getting themselves to the Start position on time.
- There will be a clock facing upstream into the warm-up area showing the race time and the next athletes to start.

## C. Start

- Athletes may move to the start position once the previous Athlete has broken the beam but must be at the start position 15 seconds before their start.
- The start is located on the river right below the hut.
- Athletes must start facing upstream holding on to the metal bar
- The beam line location: see venue map.
- At the start, there will be a countdown clock showing the time to start.
- There will be an acoustic signal (10 seconds before start - 4 shorts, 1 long - start).
- Athletes must start within 3 seconds of their start time.
- At all times, the athletes must follow the Starter's instruction or they may be disqualified for the run.

## D. Finish

- The finish beam location:



- The beam line will be marked by a finish sign on the river left.
- Athletes must exit at Equipment Control to pass through equipment control, kiss and cry and the mixed zone.
- Athletes must not leave the finish zone until dismissed by the Equipment Control Judge once they are no longer needed for the ceremonies, anti-doping or equipment control.
- During the finals, the leading athletes must proceed to the "Kiss and Cry" area located after equipment control where TV will interview them.
- There will be access to the broadcast feed in this area. If they drop out of the lead the new leaders will replace them.
- They then proceed via the mixed zone back to the Athlete area.

## 14. Location of Enquiry / Protest desk

- The Enquiry desk is located in front of OVR, just behind the scoreboard, see venue map.

## 15. Technical Video Service – set up schedule

- The Technical Video Service will be available at the TVS tent located in the first parking lot (TV Compound), see venue map.
- Please ensure your team comes between 14:30 – 16:00 on Thursday 05.07.2018 to check their equipment with the signal.
- Remember: to ensure all the systems are working under full load, Teams need to be set up at least 30 minutes prior to the competition each day – even if you are not competing until the afternoon.
- **During demonstration runs only** full length will be filmed and distributed.
- Team members must stay outside cameras view during the filming of demonstration runs

## 16. Medical Services location and availability

- Medical care will be provided by Deutsche Lebensrettungsgesellschaft (DLRG)
- There will be an ambulance & medical point during the competition in a central location, see venue map.

## 17. Awards Ceremony – Time and Location

- Awards for CSLX: Athletes have to wear their NF team uniform, not paddling gear

## 18. Team Areas

## 19. Equipment measuring and post competition control

- Equipment Control is located at bottom end of the course and is open for self-checking on Thursday, 05.07.2018 from 08:00 to **16:00**.
- Post competition control will be and random checking will occur with all boats being checked during the Finals.

## 20. Doping control station location and notification

- The doping control station is located in the Bundesleistungszentrum Kanu (BLZ), ground floor, see venue map.
- Athletes will be notified for Doping Control in the equipment control area.

## 21. Extreme Canoe Slalom

### A. Time Trials

- Time trials will be run without gates
- Time trials will be run from the ramp at the bridge and finish at the CSL finish line

### B. Final phases

#### Course

- The course map will be distributed by 17:00 Saturday 30 June.
- The course consists of 4 - 6 downstream gates
- Two sets of red upstream gates.
- At each of these the athlete must choose one of the upstream gates left or right. The Athlete may do two right or two left gates
- A full Eskimo roll (360°) needs to be performed inside the roll zone marked by buoys.
- The finish line will be marked and is above the canoe slalom Finish

#### Pre start procedure

- Athletes need to be at the start area 30 minutes prior to their heats to prepare their boats and receive their bibs and final instructions.
- Athletes may warm up in their own CSLX or slalom boat or a CSLX boat provided by the organiser
- For each phase Athletes will be given a bib numbered 1 to 4 representing their Time Trial time the fastest one will have (1), then (2), (3) and finally (4).
- Access to start will be on the bridge via stairs up on the start ramp (scaffolding)

#### Start Procedure

- The fastest boat has a right to choose their position first, then second fastest and so on...
- Athletes should be settled in the start position on the ramp 1.5 minutes before their start time.
- They should then listen to the sports presentation where they will be introduced to spectators.
- During this time, they should face the TV camera. At all times they should follow the starters instructions.
- **The start position is with paddle in both hands parallel to the boat.**
- **A screen will be set up to allow the athletes to follow their presentation process.**
- Boats will not be held at the start position, there is an automatic start system
- The starting sequence will be: READY, GO.
- Any Athlete who has a false (early) start will be disqualified (DSQ)

#### Finish

- After the finish please go to the dedicated exit on the river right just below the finish line. The start of this area will be marked by a finish sign on river right.
- Wait there for 30 secs to gather with other paddlers from your run (for TV) and then exit to kiss and cry zone – there will be someone to let you know if you were qualified for next phase.
- Please put the boat, spraydeck and bib on the trailer for return to the start.



- Helpers will collect the finals bibs at finish and bring them back to the start as quick as possible for the following heats.

## 22. Accreditation to the Venue

- The Accreditation Office is located at, see venue map.
- Accreditation will be required from Friday, 06.07.2018 when access control commences.

## 23. Car parking

- Car parking for Teams is located at the parking lots near the bottom end of the course, see venue map.
- Access to this parking is only with parking card distributed through the Accreditation Office.

## 24. Security

- There will be surveillance during the night starting from Tuesday 03.07.2018 at 19:00 till Sunday 08.07.2018.
- The Organising Committee recommends not leaving anything valuable in the tents, the cars or at the competition venue.
- The Organising Committee will not accept liability in case of theft or disappearance of equipment from the site.

## 25. Opening Ceremony

- Location: See venue map
- Commences on Thursday 05.07.2018 at 19:00 and ends at 20:00
- Athletes should gather near the Restaurant "Schaller's Hochablass Gaststätte" wearing their NF team uniform
