# 7 – Clarification about Tie break rules in QH

## B.4.2. Rules for qualification heats round:

- If the athletes have the same result in the qualification heats, the tie should be broken by a re-run (tie break run).
- The fastest athlete will be ranked highest. The original race time will be displayed on the results of the phase.
- The starting time of the re-race will be determined by the competition committee.

## • Clarification in QH :

- A tie break run will be contested only when the tie affects the progression or the start order of the next round.

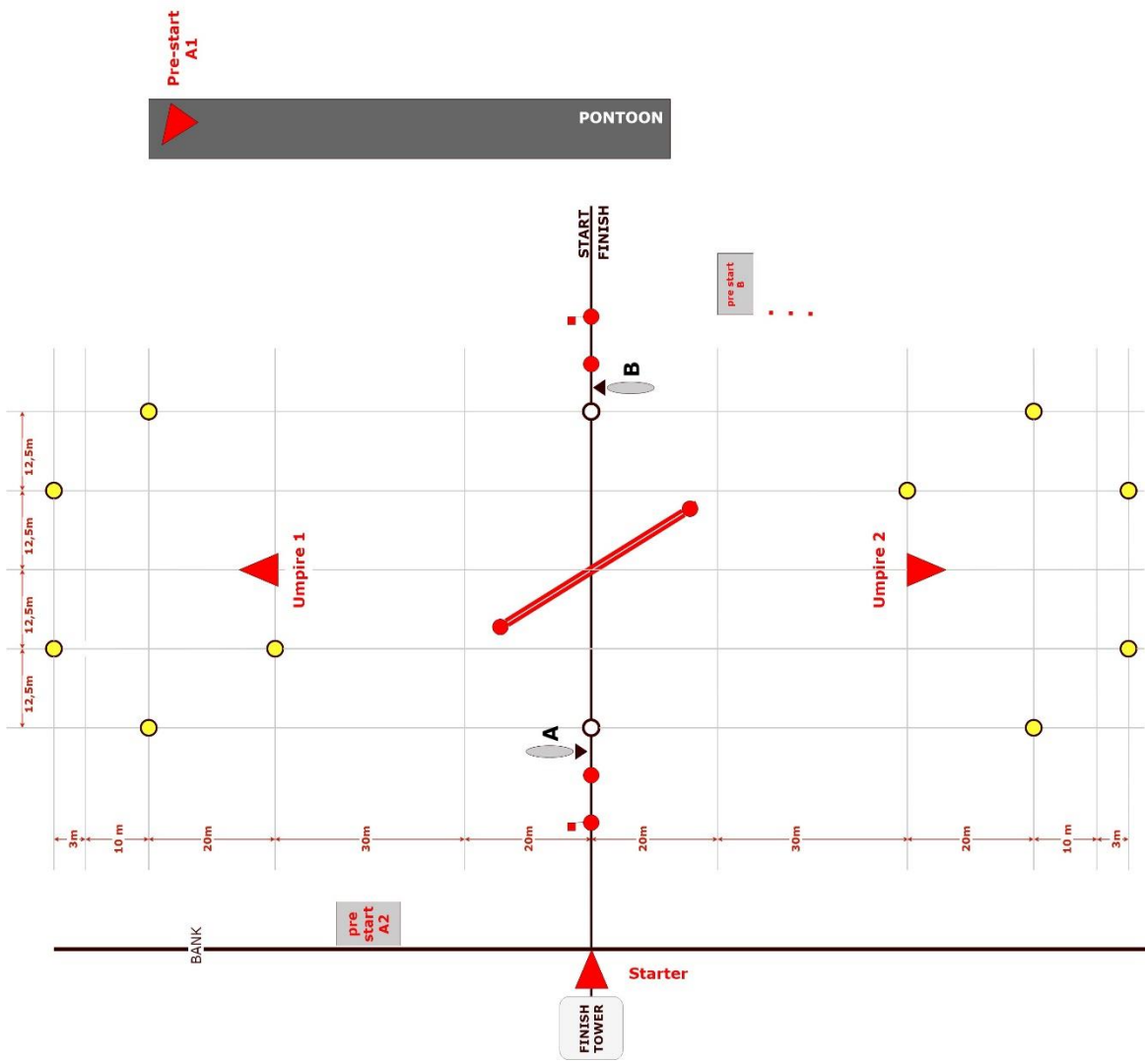

# 10 – ID CONTROL AT BOAT PARK

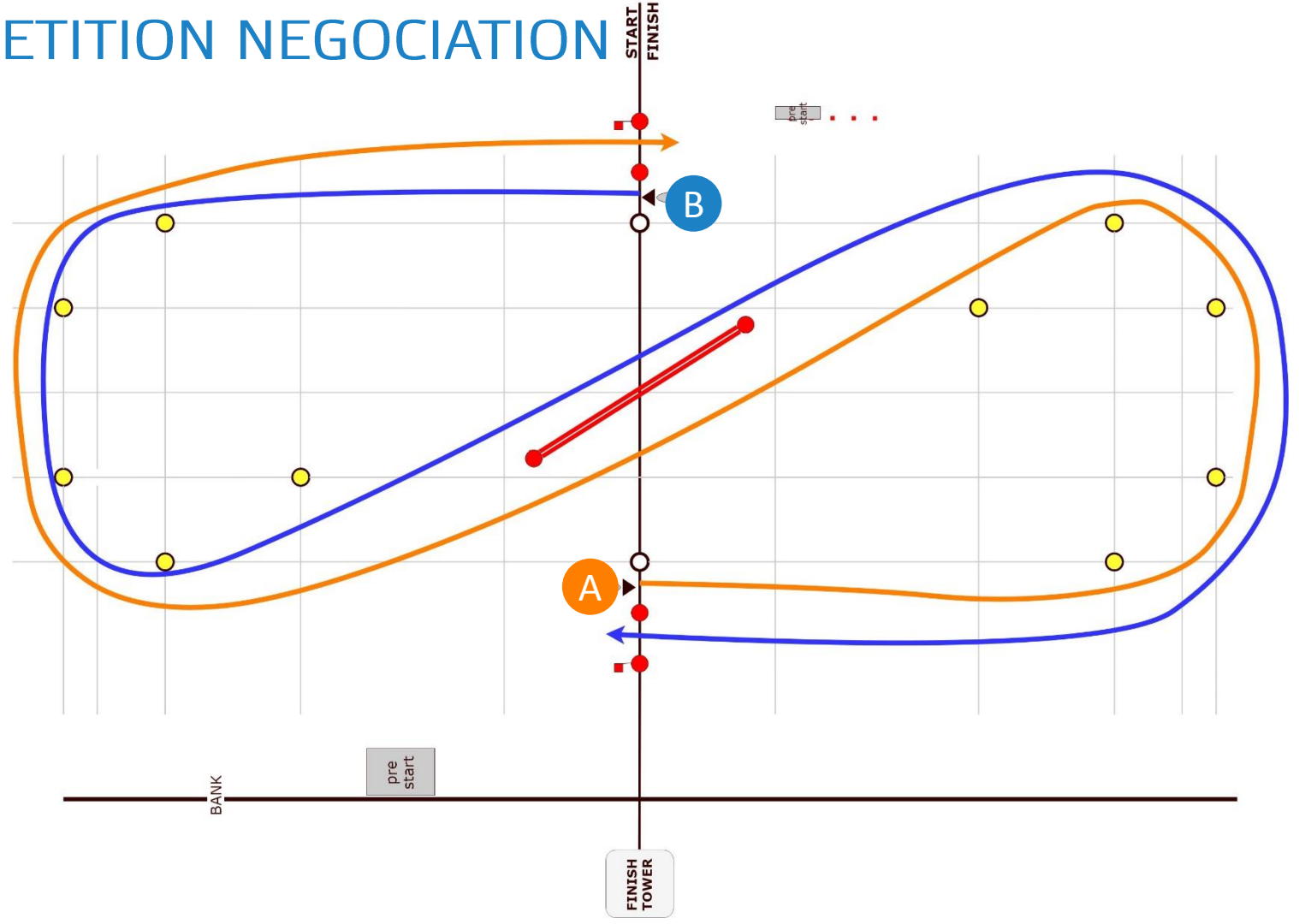
- Athletes must show accreditation card at the ID control.

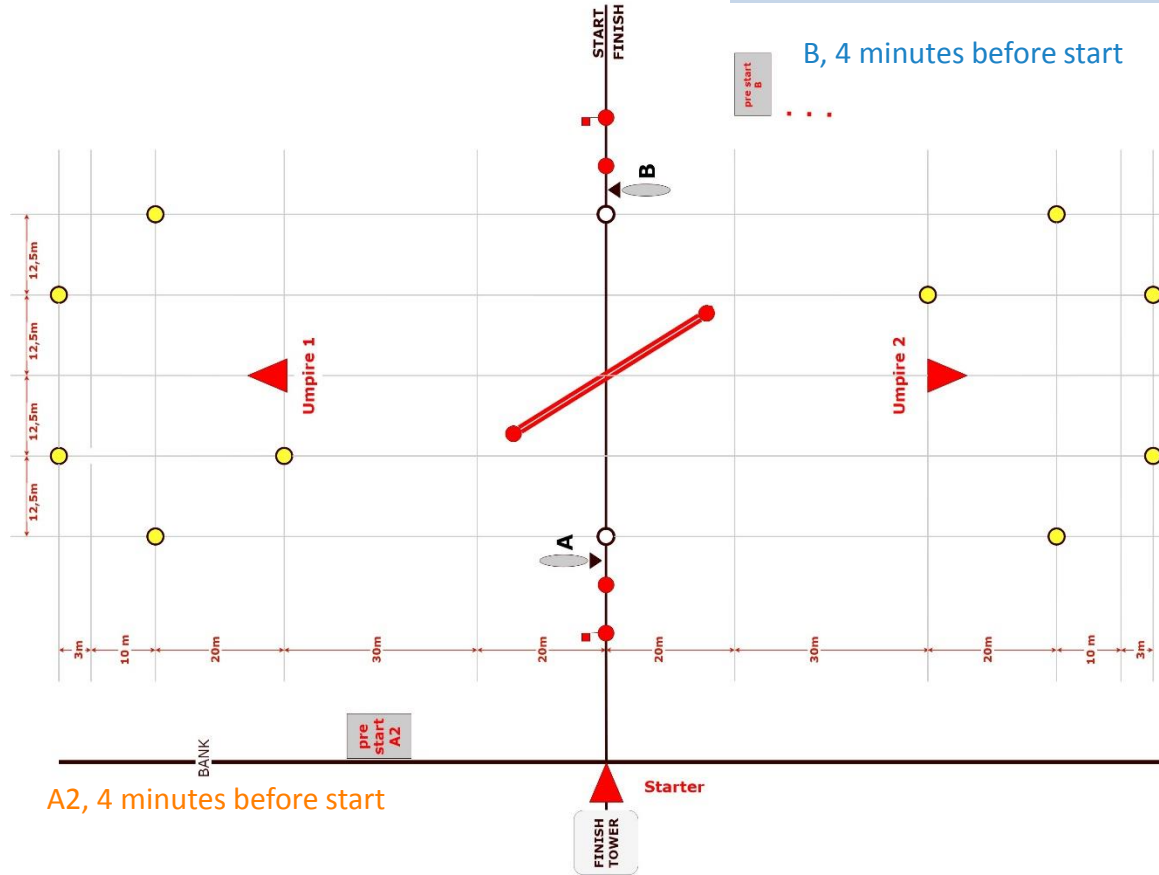
A1, 8 minutes before start

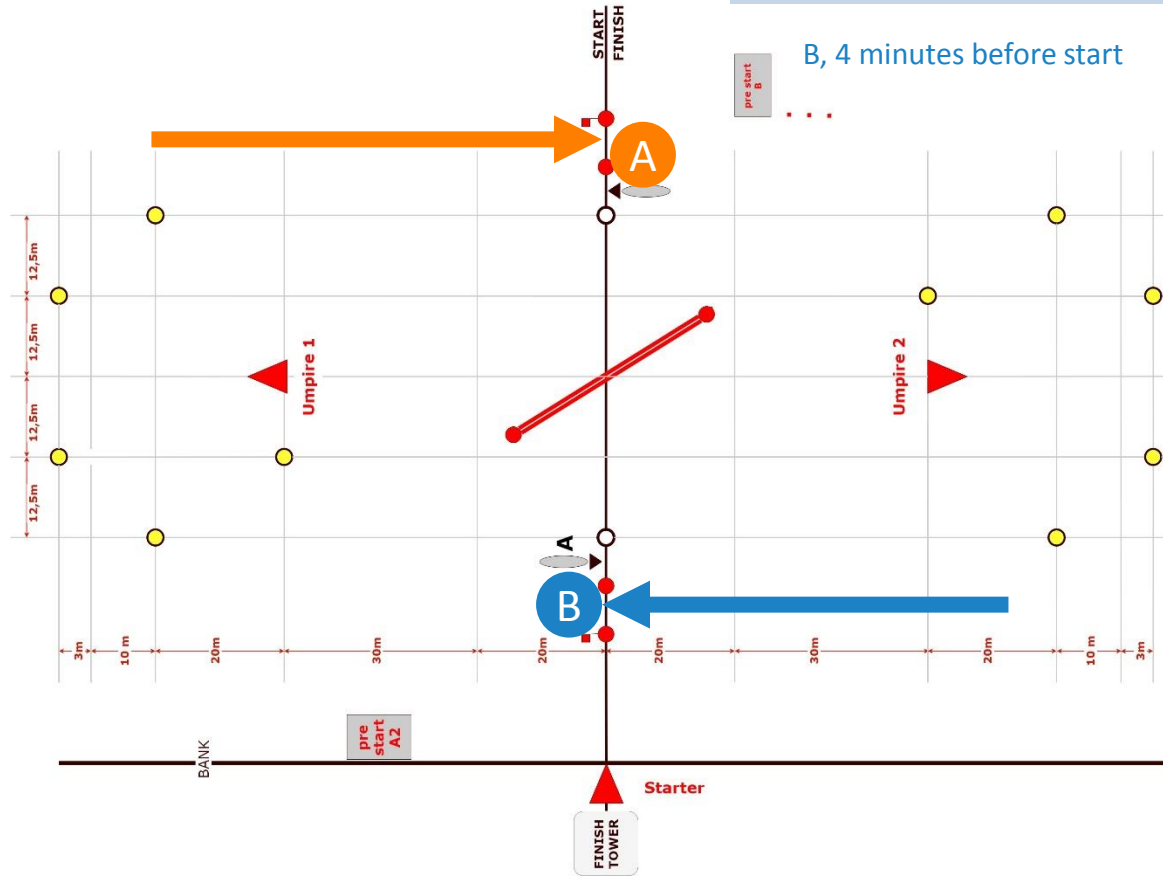

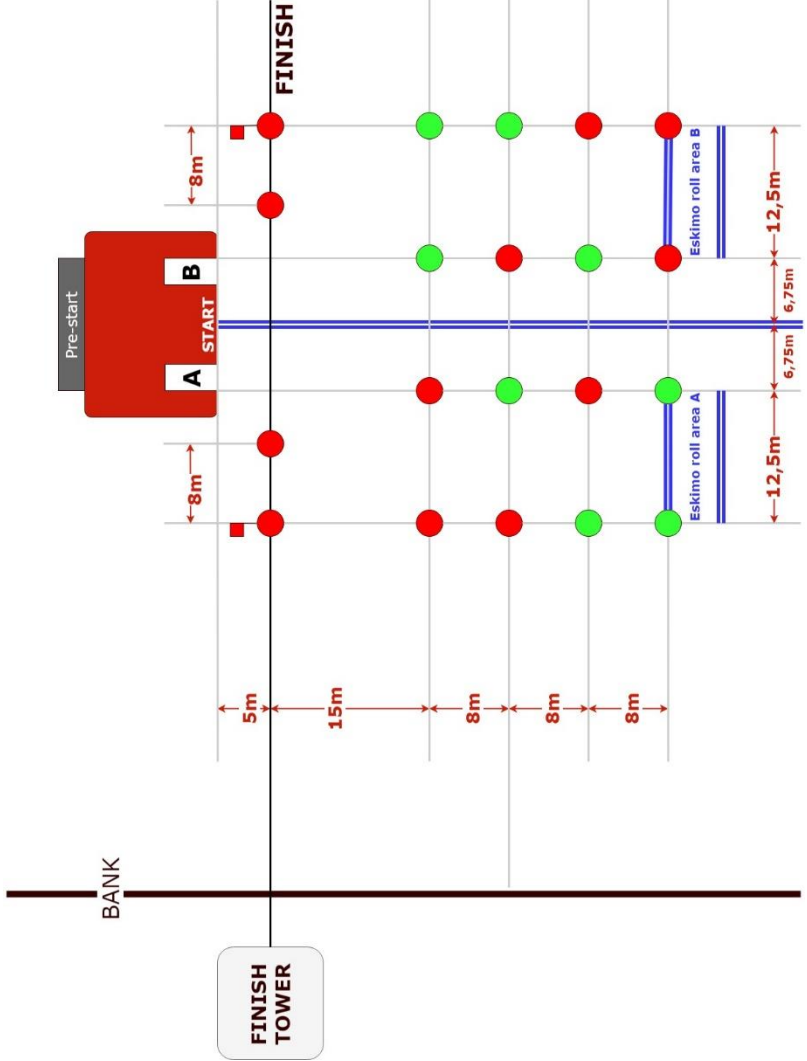

## FINISH PROCEDURE

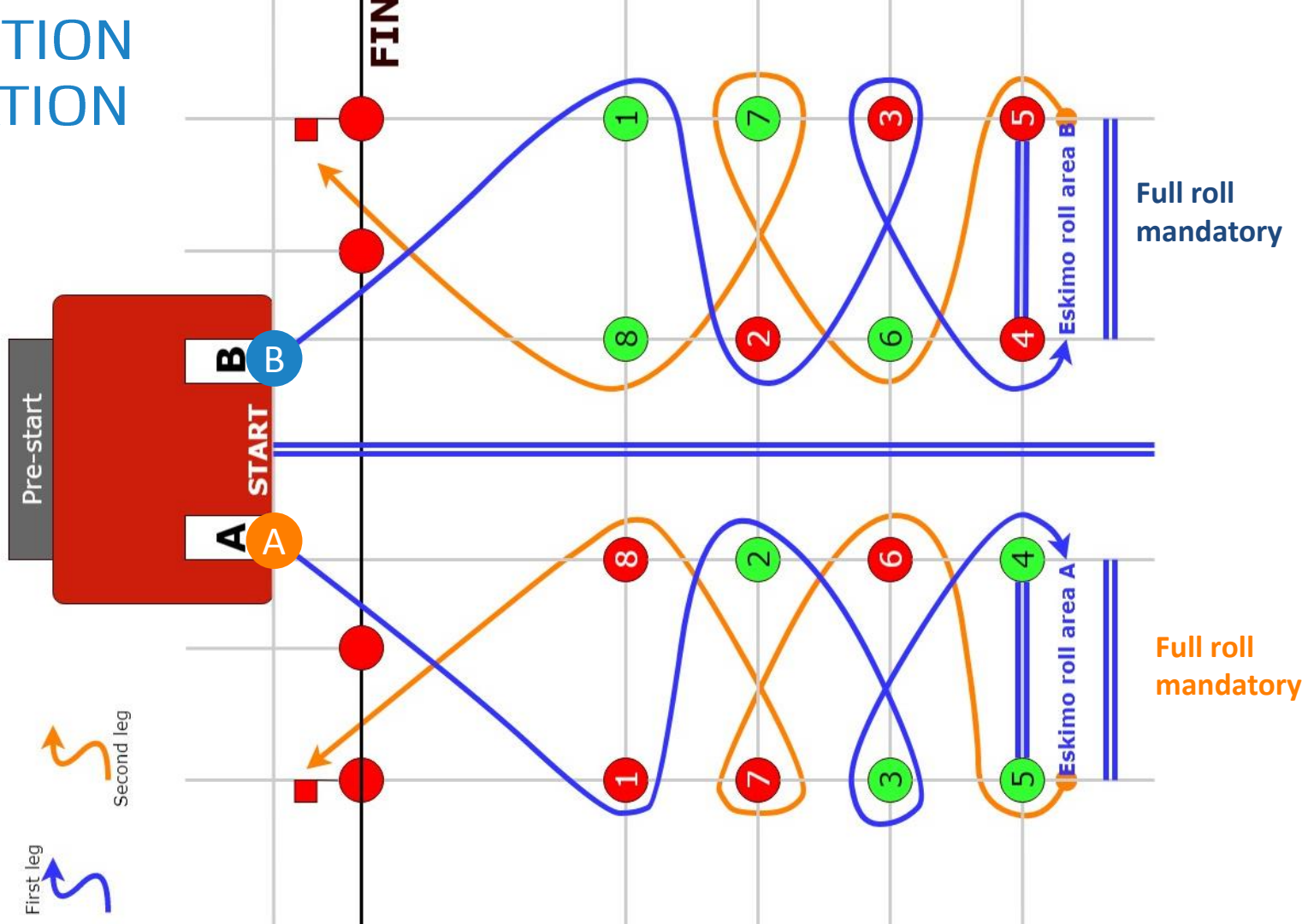
- Start procedure :

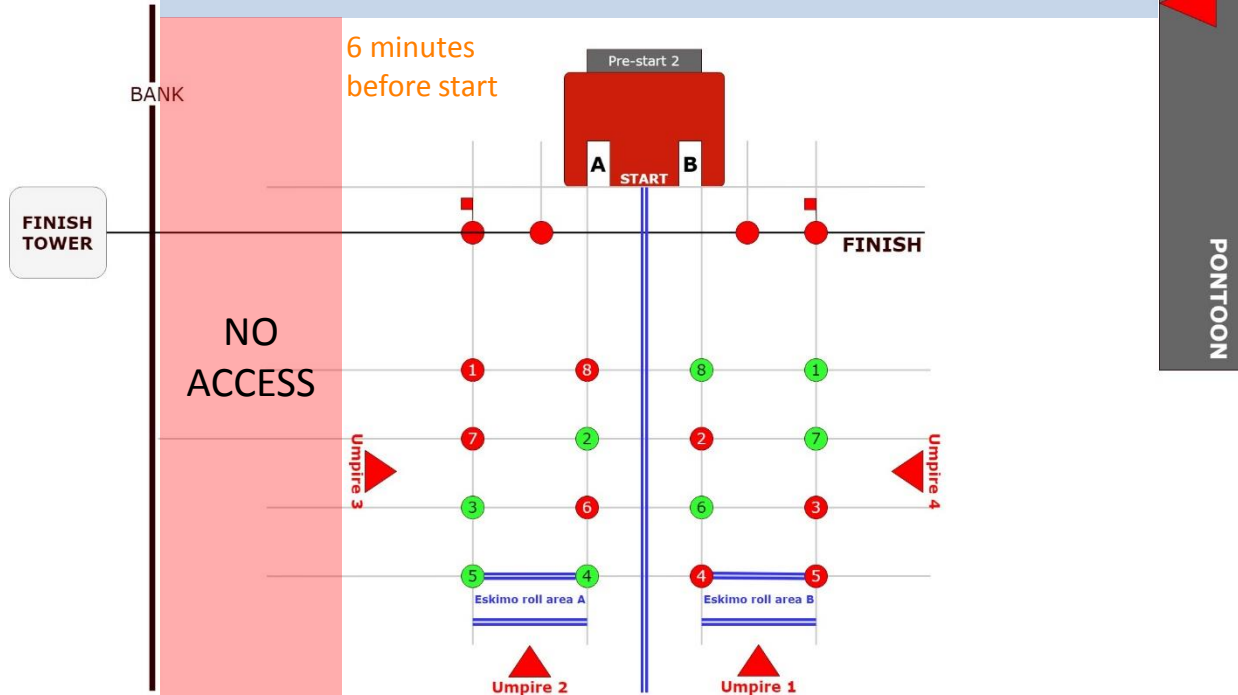

  - No protest for false start DSQ nor incorrect negotiation of the course DSQ.

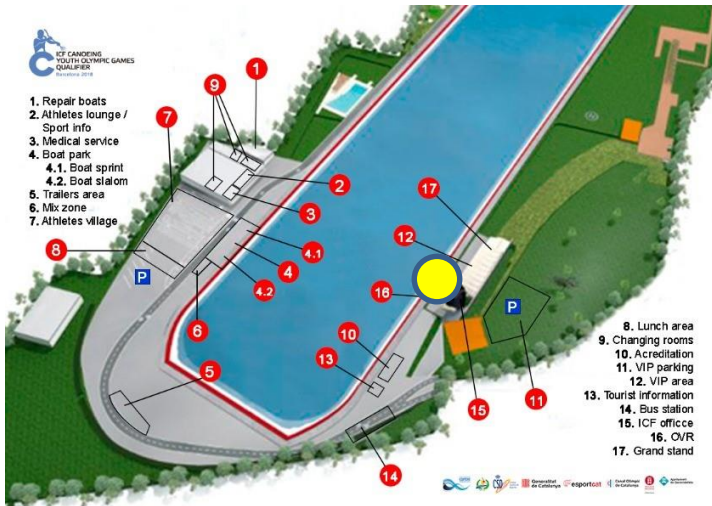
- All boats are on the weight and controlled by the ICF.
