

TECHNICAL ASPECTS OF THE COURSE

- Competition course:
 - Length: 280 meters
 - Width: 15 meters
 - $\circ~$ Drop : 5 meters with an average slope of 2%
 - Water flow during the World Cup: 12 m3
 - 50-meter conveyor belt system
- <u>Training course</u>: 200-meter, warm-up and cool-down areas linked to the "Gave de Pau" river.

EVENTS & COMPETITION SCHEDULE

OFFICIAL TRAINING

The competition venue will be open to all the National Federations and secured from the Monday 9th June 2025 to Sunday 15th June 2025.

Participating National Federations will have access to Canoë Slalom official training sessions from **Monday 9th to Thursday 12th June** as follows:

- 1 slot of training per day and per nation.
- 25 to 30 boats per group.
- Different courses designs will be setup every day by the Organizing Committee.
- Water safety will be ensured by the Organizing Committee.

Participating National Federations will have access to 3 Kayak Cross official training slots on **Tuesday 10th, Thursday 12th and Saturday 14th**.



SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT

Pau Canoe Événements has continued its commitment to sustainable development and CSR during the 2022 ICF Canoe Slalom World Cup: the association received the gold award for the sustainable development approach "Développement durable, le sport s'engage", by the CNOSF. (French Olympic Sports National Committee).

For the first time in 2022, this gold level was awarded to an event in France, all disciplines combined.

This level was achieved through the organization of multiple actions and entertainment events carried out before, during and after the Canoe Slalom World Cup.

All stakeholders of the event (organizers, athletes, leaders, partners and the public) are committed to respecting and getting involved in a sustainable and eco-responsible approach.

In 2025, after two years without a World Cup, we aim to maintain the Gold level for this edition! But to do this, you will understand that we also count on your support to help us raise awareness and teach good manners regarding sustainable development and CSR issues through social networks and ensure proper respect for the actions implemented in the Athletes Village and on the competition site.



VISA REQUIREMENTS

France is a state-member of the European Union. The French Embassy in your country will provide you with all detailed information about visas. You will find details in the website on the French Foreign Affairs Ministry (http://www.diplomatie.gouv.fr/en/).

Please inform the Organizing Committee in advance, but **no later than 13th April 2025,** whether your team needs entry visas to France and provide the visa application form duly filled in.

SPECIAL REGULATION IN FRANCE

Evin laws (N. 91-32 January 10th 1991)

 This law forbids advertising for all alcoholic beverages (any level of alcohol including beer) and tobacco inside sports arenas (a canoe slalom stadium is a sports arena). No advertising on tracksuits, boats, paddles ...

Protection of athlete health law (N. 99-223 March 23th 1999)

Specific anti-doping regulations on French territory.



MEDICAL CARE, INSURANCE, DOPING CONTROL

FIRST AID

The first aid station for participating countries will be located in the Organization Back Office building from 9th to 12th June. The NF advises all participants that emergency medical services will cover only emergency cases and that all participants are responsible for arranging medical insurance policy at their own cost.

WATER SAFETY

Rescuing in the competition area will be organized only during the competition days. Countries are responsible of their athletes during the training period. However, there will always be someone in HOC office to help contacting first aid or emergency station if needed.

MEDICAL INSURANCE

The Organising Committee kindly asks all participants of the 2025 ICF Canoe Slalom World Cup to arrange medical insurance policy in their respective countries. All costs above the regular first aid and ambulance services are to be covered by this medical insurance policy. The Organizing Committee will not cover any expenses in connection with hospital treatment.

DOPING CONTROL

Doping control will be performed in accordance with the ICF Anti-doping requirements and WADA standards.
