

#### 4. LOCATION AND VENUE INFORMATION

How to reach Klong Bang Phai Whitewater Course, Pattaya-Rayong, Thailand. Teams should fly to Suvarnabhumi Airport, Don Mueang Airport, U - Tapao Airport. The trip from the airport to the venue is approximately 2 hours by car.









For a small fee RCAT is pleased to assist teams with buses to reach the venue.

The artificial whitewater course is nestled in the compound of the 48000sq/m at the Rowing and Canoeing Association Training Center. The facilities are designed to serve as a training center for water sports athletes; mainly the RCAT's national teams of canoe – kayak sprint, rowing, and canoe slalom. There are also jogging and cycling tracks to serve the health-concerned neighboring community.

8.1 Official Training period
