The city of Plattling is proud and delighted to host the Canoe Freestyle World Championships from June 15 to June 22, 2025.





2.6 Statement regarding the Water Level

Please be advised that the water levels in Plattling are currently very low. Exercise caution when paddling in these conditions. It is essential to wear an appropriate helmet and to avoid paddling alone. The competition will take place on a rain-fed natural river, and we are experiencing the 6th driest year in Germany since 1881. At this time, it is impossible to predict rainfall for the next four weeks, making it difficult to estimate the water levels at that time. The committee is closely monitoring the water levels and will make a decision as we approach the event.

3 LOCATION

3.1 Location of airports, rail network and roads to the venue/city

Arrival by car:

Plattling has two highway exits on the A92: Plattling-Nord and Plattling-West. Plattling-West is the one to take from the Munich direction, Plattling-Nord is the one to take if you drive down from the north.

Arrival by train:

Plattling has its own train station, which is only 1,9 km away from the wave, so about a 20-minute walk.

Arrival by plane:

The closest airport to Plattling is Munich Airport. There is a train station at the airport where you can take the train to Plattling. This takes 1h 45 min with one change of trains in Freising.

There is also a train station in Frankfurt Airport with a direct train to Plattling, which takes 4 hours. It is possible to take your boat on trains.

3.2 Weather and Water in May/June

The competition will take place in early summer and the average daily temperature is about 20°C. The water temperature of the river Isar is about 18°C at that time of the year.

3.3 Currency

The currency used in Germany is the Euro €. In shops, restaurants and hotels, major credit cards are widely accepted, though smaller shops like bakeries etc. might only accept cash. In Plattling, you'll find numerous ATMs at the main square in town.

3.4 Local Attractions

The 2025 World Championships in Plattling will take place at the same time as the annual local Bavarian festival in town, "Plattlinger Volksfest".

The "Bayerischer Wald" – the highlands north of Plattling is just a stone's throw away. You can go there for hiking or mountain biking. 30 minutes away by car is the "Geisskopf", where the oldest bike park in Europe is located. With lift access and bike rental.

Plattling has a public outdoor pool, just a 10-minute walk away. There is also a nice swimming pool with a spa area in Deggendorf, 9 km north of Plattling.

You can easily reach the beautiful cities of Passau and Munich by train. (0:30 and 1:30 h)

VENUE

3.5 Description of competition venue and sports infrastructure

The Plattling Wave is located in a nature reserve and has served as a meeting place for the European freestyle scene for years. Every year, there are training camps and all kinds of competitions. We have already organised many national championships, EuroCups, WorldCups, the European Championships 2016 and the World Championships 2011.

Since the World's, Plattling has been one of the most popular playspots in the world. The sections upper and below the wave offer numerous possibilities for first paddling attempts. The lower Isar below the feature is one of the most beautiful canoe tours in Bavaria. The Isar wave is the ideal training spot for beginners. It is not only professionals who appreciate the easy entrance and their large eddy. In summertime, the large green areas also attract numerous sun worshipers to chill, refresh and barbecue. Not a few of them venture into the waves with short surfboards. So the Isarwave has already made a name for itself in the surfer's scene.

3.7 Presentation of the technical aspects of the wave

The 60 Metres wide wave is formed by a stopper that has been built to protect the riverbed from getting washed out, so it protects the bridge upstream.

3.8 Feature

The Isarwelle in Plattling is a hole feature that tends to become wavy with higher flows.

The Isarwelle in Plattling is well known and one of the best Playspots in Germany. This is mainly due to the surrounding conditions. The wave is suitable for beginners. It is easier than everywhere else to enter the wave from the eddy and the big eddy is catching everyone back after a flush or an occasional swim. The competition takes place on the left river side.

Squirt boaters paddle in the big eddy for their moves and use the eddy line for their mystery moves.

Water level Isar, Plattling (update every 15 minutes)

< 160 cm: boney, easy to hit rocks at the bottom

160 - 190 cm: still bony, but you'll find sweet spots where it is possible to do all moves

190 - **210** cm: perfect! At 200 cm, you won't hit a rock at the bottom anymore. To set up tricks is easy; the hole is easy to maneuver

210 - 220 cm: still very good. The hole gets flatter. Plugging loops becomes a bit more difficult, spins get easier

220 - **240** cm: The hole gets a bit flatter. Still good for all hole moves, perfect for beginners, and endless surfing. Professionals should take a look at the wave on the river right - it gets more wavy there.

240 - 280 cm: Very flat wave on river left, still good for beginners - take care of the eddy line! Beautiful wave on the river right!

280 cm: Meadow starts to be flooded. / Still a good wave up to

290cm. At 300 cm, the wave flattens out and is not suitable for freestyle boats anymore.

As we approach nearly two years since the loss of our beloved friend Danny, we are dedicated to preserving his legacy with an award in his honor. First introduced at the last World Championships in Columbus, this award will continue to be presented biennially at the CFR World Championships just before the Men's & Women's K1 Senior medal ceremony. It recognizes individuals who have made a unique impact on the sport of freestyle. We are proud to continue this tradition and celebrate Danny's life. The award will be given to someone, chosen by a panel, who has significantly contributed to the freestyle community.

4.10 Folk Festival

During the time of the CFR World Championships, a vibrant folk festival takes place, beginning on Wednesday, June 17th, delighting both participants and visitors. This festival offers a wonderful opportunity to experience local culture, savor traditional foods, and enjoy musical performances. In addition to exciting rides and games, there are numerous stalls featuring crafts and regional specialties. The folk festival creates a festive atmosphere and perfectly complements the sporting events, ensuring entertainment and enjoyment for the whole family.

5 TRAINING

5.1 Official Training

Official training will take place from Wednesday, 11 June to Sunday, 15 June 2025.

There will be 1 training slot per day per nation. Exact timings will be determined after the numeric entries close. Additional open training opportunities will also be scheduled. Training on the Isarwave is free of charge.

5.2 Masters Training

A dedicated timeslot for the Masters will be scheduled in the evening, right before the wave is opened to everyone, following each day of training.

5.3 Unofficial Training

Paddling on the Isarwave is free of charge. Make sure to check the water level online: https://m.hnd.bayern.de/pegel.php?pgnr=16008506

The best time is early summer and of course, late summer and fall after solid rainfalls.

5.4 Water Safety

Please keep in mind that the Isar is a natural river, which presents varying risks depending on the water levels. Wearing safety equipment such as helmets and buoyancy aids is mandatory. Always paddle with a group and keep an eye on your fellow paddlers to ensure mutual safety.

During the competition and official Training, a local water rescue team safety crew will be on the water.

5.5 Water quality

The Isar River in Plattling has sufficient quality for bathing.

6 ACCOMMODATION & CAR HIRE

6.1 Camping at the venue for accredited persons

During the Event, camping on the Event Site is provided for accredited persons! Toilets are available on site. There won't be any showers or power supply on site. The showers of the local swimming pool can be used by all accredited persons for free. As the Isar-Wave is located in a conservation area, we kindly ask you to keep the meadow clean!

6.2 Camping at the venue for non-accredited individuals

For non-accredited individuals, camping at the event site is available for a fee of €5 per day or €30 per week. The camping fee can be paid at the Event Information desk or at the Race Office.

6.3 Additional CamperVan Space

7 ENTRY

7.1 Entry process & deadlines

Entries and accreditation requests must be made by the National Federation using the ICF's online entries system (SDP) https://icf.mev.atos.net/icf/

Numerical Entries

Numerical entries close: 16 May 2025

- You must submit through SDP the number of athletes you will enter in each event.
- Please also give indicative numbers for the overall number of athletes and team personnel who will attend the event with your delegation.

Nominal Entries

- Nominal entries close: 6 June 2025
- Each athlete competing must be entered by name.
- Team personnel must also be submitted for accreditation at this time.

These entries will be used to produce the accreditation cards for all teams. Entries or accreditation requests sent directly to the committee or the event organiser will NOT be accepted.

7.2 Participation fee

A Participation Fee of 250 € will be charged for each accredited athlete and team official to cover the duration of the Official Training and Competition phases of the 2025 ICF Canoe Freestyle World Championships in Plattling.

The participation fee will include the following services:

- Entry to the 2025 ICF Canoe Freestyle World Championships competition
- Access to the Opening Ceremony
- Access to Athlete/Team accredited areas
- Public wifi access at the venue
- Free parking on site
- Emergency first aid during Official Training and Competition times
- Water safety during Competition and official Training

- Refreshments/snacks during the competition
- Athlete welcome package
- Entry to Festival Events aimed at ICF Competitors

The judges' fee will be between €40 and €50. The amount will be announced after the nominal entry.

10 Anti-Doping

10.1 Doping Control

Doping control will be performed in accordance with the ICF Anti-doping requirements and WADA standards.

10.2 Anti-Doping Education

In line with ICF rules for ICF World Championships, ICF World Cups and ICF Ranking Races and Continental Championships, every athlete, coach and support personnel must pass the relevant anti-doping online course on the Anti-doping Education Learning Platform (ADEL) corresponding to their role: ICF (ADEL) online anti-doping course. If someone has already completed the

<u>course</u>, they do not have to re-take it. If you are unsure whether you have completed the course, please contact your National Federation.

11 OPENING CEREMONY

The Opening Ceremony will take place on Sunday, June 15th, from 4:00 PM to 5:30 PM at Magdalenenplatz in Plattling (Preysingplatz 1, 94447 Plattling, Germany). Teams are asked to arrive between 3:30 PM and 3:45 PM to be ready for the opening ceremony at 4:00 PM.

Teams are asked to:

- Arrive in National Federation tracksuits and accreditation between 3:30 PM and 3:45 PM, ready for the opening ceremony at 4:00 PM.
- Assemble at Magdalenenplatz in Plattling.
- Nominate one female and one male per team to carry the flag and country signage (both provided by the organizing committee).
- Have the entire team and leaders join the opening ceremony, staying behind the flag throughout the event.

Schedule:

1. Opening Ceremony:

The ceremony begins with the official welcome and the raising of the flags. Speeches by distinguished guests and cultural performances form the core of the event.

2. Departure of Athletes and Parade to the Isar Wave:

After the opening ceremony, the athletes will parade to the Isar Wave. During the parade, teams will follow the flag in alphabetical order by nation, with Germany leading.

3. Reception at the Isar Wave:

At the Isar Wave, non-alcoholic cocktails and pizza will be served. Here, athletes can celebrate the conclusion of the ceremony in a convivial atmosphere.
