NUMERICAL ENTRIES

- Numerical entries close: 1st June 2019
- You must submit through SDP the number of athletes you will enter into each event.
- Please also give indicative numbers for the overall number of athletes and team personnel who will attend the event with your delegation.

NOMINAL ENTRIES

- Nominal entries close: 16th June 2019
- Each athlete competing must be entered by name.
- Team personnel must also be submitted for accreditation at this time. These entries will be used to produce the accreditation cards for all teams.

REMINDER

Entries or accreditation requests sent directly to the committee or the event organiser will NOT be accepted.







PARTICIPATION FEE

The Participation fee will be charged per each athlete and team official for the Access Period, 23rd June – 30th June 2019.

The amount of the Participation fee is 15€ per day for the Access Period, which means 105 € in total.

The participation fee will include the following services: Athlete's Village, Official video service, Boat storage, Security, Internet Access, Access pass and parking, Information regarding the accommodation, Free training period, First aid, Flat-water training, Invitation letter for VISA applications.

The accreditation fee has to be paid in advance by 21st June 2019 via the bank transfer to make the accreditation process more convenient. At the venue in the info office credit or debit cards will be accepted as well as payment in cash.

COMPETITION

Competition Rules

The 2019 ICF Canoe Slalom World Cup race will be run in accordance with the ICF Canoe Slalom competition rules.

Athlete's Village

Athlete's village with a big tent for the athletes will be located near the competition area. Teams will have a place for relaxation with tables and chairs. Toilets will be available near the big tent.

Internet Access

High Speed Wireless internet access will be available at the venue – the competition area, all office spaces, including ICF offices, Jury, Accreditation office and Media Centre.

Access pass and parking

Free access pass and car parking near the athlete's village will be guaranteed for up to two accredited vehicles.

Official video service

Technical video signal will be provided during the competition days.

Boat storage

Boat storage racks will be placed near athlete's village.

First aid

A small tent with first aid will be located in the finish area. The NF will advise all participants that emergency medical services will cover only emergency cases and that all participants are responsible to arrange medical insurance policy at their own cost.

Water safety

Rescuing in the competition area will be organised during the competition days.

Medical Insurance

Organising Committee kindly asks all participants of the 2019 ICF Canoe Slalom World Cup race to ensure medical insurance policy in their respective countries. All costs above the regular first aid and ambulance services are to be covered by this medical insurance policy. Organising Committee will not cover any expenses in connection with hospital or dental treatment.

Doping control

Doping control will be performed in accordance with the ICF Anti-doping requirements and WADA standards.
