## Entries:

According to ICF Canoe Slalom rules, in article 44.3.1, each national federation can enter up to 5 boats per event. However 4 boats must have qualified via the ICF Ranking of the previous season. By October 1<sup>st</sup> the year preceding the ICF competitions, the Canoe Slalom committee will publish the ICF Ranking along the qualified quotas for each national federation for the following year's World Cup competitions.

Numerical entries: will close 45 days before competition: 18<sup>th</sup> July.

Nominal entries must be received 14 days prior to the first day of competition of each respective World Cup according to article 44.3.2 in ICF Canoe Slalom rules: Friday 18<sup>th</sup> August .

Nominal entries must be processed via SDP software (<https://icf.msl.es/icf/main.jsp>).

Late entries will have to be accepted by the Chairman of Canoe Slalom committee (Jean-Michel PRONO) according to ICF Canoe Slalom Rules.

- 18<sup>th</sup> July: closing of numerical entries
- 18<sup>th</sup> August: closing of nominal entries

### **Stadio della Canoa "Città d'Ivrea"**

- **Length:** 240 metres
- **Width:** 17 metres
- **Drop:** 7 metres, gradient of 3.5
- **Water flow:** 10 m<sup>3</sup>
- **Warm-up area:** upperstream before the start line, gates are provided both in flat water and whitewater; cool-down area downstream after the finish line.

During the training you will paddle on your own responsibility and costs.

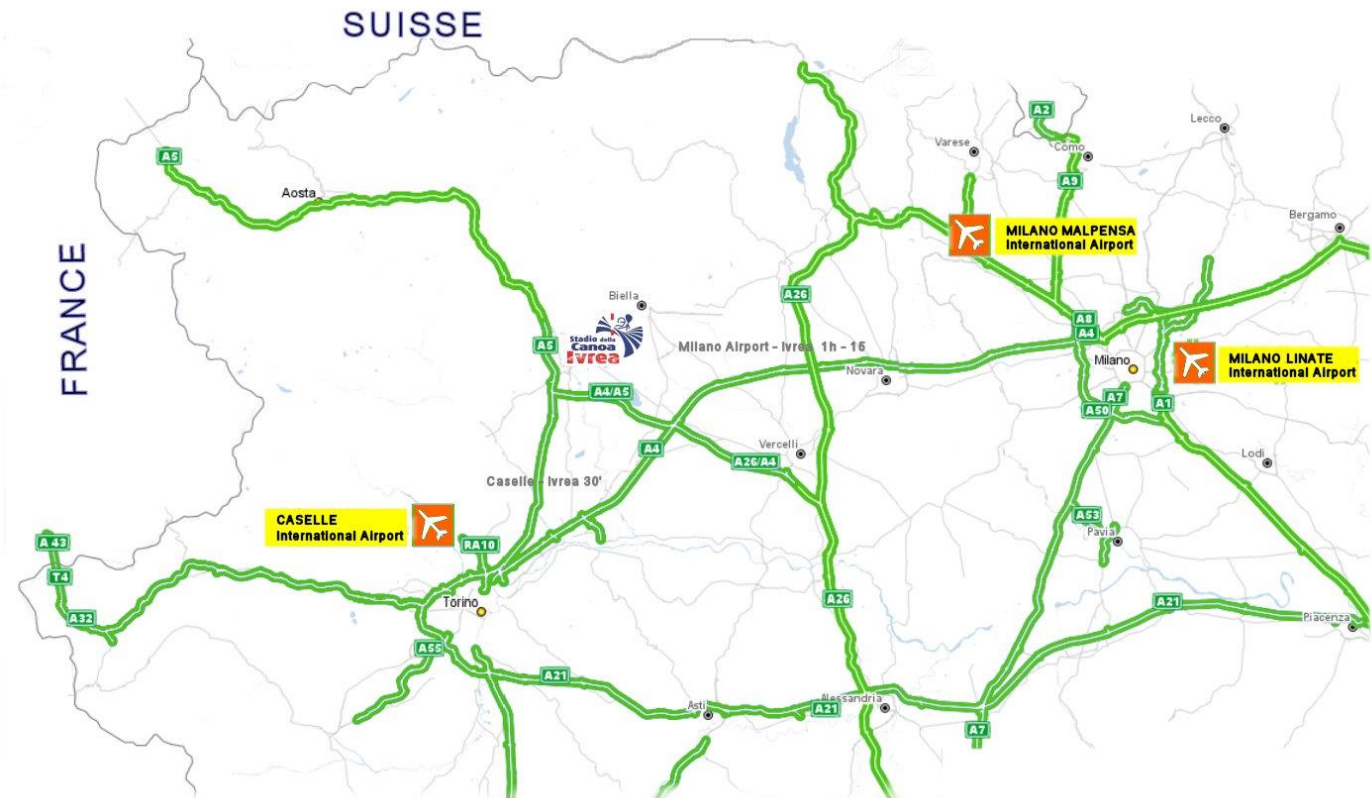

### Accommodation:

In according with Regione Piemonte, Main Partner of HOC, accommodation will be in charge of Ventana Group, that recently took over Booking Piemonte.

Ventana Group is in charge of accommodation for all canoe and kayak events, in all disciplines, on the whole territory of Piemonte region.

### **Safety rules:**

Each competitor must wear a safety helmet with a strap fastened under the chin and a buoyancy jacket (article 19.2, ICF Canoe Slalom rules).

A buoyancy jacket must comply with the current industry standard that meets ISO 12402-5 (level 50) or any national standard that meets the same requirement and be ICF registered (article 19.2.1, ICF Canoe Slalom rules).

The safety helmet must comply with EN 1385 and be ICF registered (article 19.2.2, ICF Canoe Slalom rules).

### **Opening period:**

The competition venue will be opened to all delegations and secured from Monday 28<sup>th</sup> August at 08.00 to Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> September after the Closing Ceremony.

### **Official training:**

Delegations will have access to official training from 28<sup>th</sup> August to 31<sup>st</sup> August as follows:

- 1 training slot per day and per nation.
- 25 to 30 boats per group.
- Different course design will be set up every day by the Organising Committee.
- Water safety will be ensured by the Organising Committee.

### **Visa:**

Italy is a State-member of the European Union. The Italian Embassy in your country will provide you with all details information about visas. Please inform in advance but not later than 30<sup>th</sup> March 2017 the Organising Committee together with the visa form whether your team needs entry visas to Italy.
