Bratislava Athlete Meeting Feedback

At the 2018 European Championships a group of athletes and coaches called a meeting with the ICF Freestyle Committee members present at the event to present some questions and concerns. These issues were addressed at the September ICF freestyle committee meeting. In response to the questions raised we would like to provide the following feedback and updates.

- The 2019 ICF Freestyle Kayak World Championships dates have been confirmed as the 1st 7th July 2019. *There is a possibility it could start as early as the 30th June depending on the location and format used for the squirt boating event. Exact start date will be announced as soon as the schedule is confirmed.
- The freestyle feature development is a top priority for Sort. Development is due to commence in December 2018. The goal is to create a world class feature. We will keep you up to date on the progress through the ICF freestyle committee facebook page.
- Freestyle Committee will be supporting the organisers in Sort to ensure the best possible level of service, safety and support is available to athletes at this event.
- Details on how to register for the World Championships including entry fees and judging fees are being finalised and will be announced soon.
