Channel: left

Course Length: 280m

Flow rate: 15 m3 / sec.

Grade: III/IV

The Čunovo Water Sports Centre is an artificial whitewater slalom course in Slovakia, on an island in the Danube river, 14 km southeast of Bratislava, near the village of Čunovo. It is powered by flow diversion from the Čunovo dam. During the 2021 whole left course came through complex modernisation with use of RapidBlocs system.

There are two separated channels – right and left, which could be combined into combination of the right to left. Nowadays left channel is used for slalom, while right channel is mainly used for a rafting.

Since 1997, venue has hosted a full schedule of local, regional, and international competitions, including multiple World Cup races, 2002 and 2010 European Championships, 2011 World Championships, 2017 Junior & U23 World Championships and 2021 Slalom, Extreme slalom and Sprint World Championships.
