

2017 ICF Anti-Doping Statistics

The statistics reported for the ICF in-competition and out-of-competition programs cover tests that are initiated by the ICF or its representatives. These statistics do not include in-competition and out-of-competition testing initiated by National Federations or National Anti-Doping Organizations.

→ Overall number of Doping Control: **364 tests**

(685 tests including the NADO tests: 303 in-Competition, 382 out-of-competition)

2017 In-competition testing statistics

The ICF is responsible for Anti-Doping testing during ICF Competitions which includes Junior and Senior World Championships and World Cups in all disciplines.

The ICF performed **180 in-competition tests** as testing authority.
