ICF BOARD DOES NOT RECOMMEND TO IMPLEMENT THIS CHANGE

- Serving simultaneously as President, with the duty of addressing suggestions from the board and inputs
 from the National Federation, is a significant challenge.
- Appointing a Chairperson could streamline this responsibility, ensuring a more organized, efficient, and potentially more democratic Congress.

Article n°16.1 Ease the access to the congress and proxy vote (1)

Each National Federation has the right to appoint up to three (3) delegates from its National Federation to the Congress one of whom has the right to vote. If there are three (3) delegates, at least one (1) should be from the other gender. Delegates must be official members of that particular National Federation (Eg. Staff, Board Member, official).

Each National Federation has the right to appoint up to three (3) delegates from its National Federation to the Congress one of whom has the right to vote. If there are three (3) delegates, at least one (1) should be from the other gender. Delegates must be official members of that particular National Federation (Eg. Staff, Board Member, official). ICF will cover the travel and accommodation expenses for two subsequent Congresses of one delegate from the National Federation which has never participated at the Congress.



If a member of the Special Congress does not send its written note within the deadline, the proposal shall automatically be considered as accepted by the member.

CONTEXT MODIFICATION REQUIRED

In Hungary, all entities must prepare financial statements every year that need to be approved by the supreme body. Therefore, under the Financial Rules also the following topics need to be regulated:

- ICF' business year ends on 31 December,
- the annual reports need to be approved by the Congress,

Since the Congress meetings are held every second year only, it is necessary to introduce an accelerated procedure for the purpose of the approval of the annual report (e.g decision-making via electronic means). The annual report must be approved by the highest authority and this new structure and opportunity would present a mire transparent a modern approach.

According to Hungarian Law all modification applications to the Court must be submitted within 60 days as of the day when the respective decision is made.

Article n°21.5 AMENDMENTS TO THE STATUTES AND COMPETITION RULES

 As a general principle the Congress shall be the highest authority of the Federation, and this is a very unusual provision. We cannot exclude that the court might find it violating general principles of Hungarian law.

MODIFICATION RECOMMENDED

In the Civil Act such economic-business activities are defined as income- or wealth-generating, profit-oriented economic activities conducted on a regular basis, except for:

b) activities aimed at achieving the objectives outlined in the deed of foundation (including public benefit activities).

The profit before tax derived from the core activities laid down in the deed of foundation of ICF would not be subject to corporate income tax.

Therefore, it is crucial to clearly define all the aspects of the activities ICF intends to perform as an association in Hungary in order to reach the envisaged tax-exempt status from a corporate income tax perspective.

Article n°26 ICF BOARD OF DIRECTORS

• It needs to be regulated, which officers are entitled to represent and sign on behalf of ICF (for example, the President, the Secretary General, etc.) and whether they have individual or joint signature right. **The representatives will also be registered in the Hungarian public registry**, therefore, this information must be included in the ICF. Byelaws regarding expenditure over 50.000 euros remain unchanged.

- According to the current wording, the modification of the Statutes is allowed only "every two years". Such a restriction
 would be quite unusual under Hungarian law and can make an obstacle to make necessary amendments on time.
- The Board should be able to respond to situations and possible challenges arising from the relocation of the seat.


