





Location: Equipment Control is located on the **left side of the finish pool**, **just after** the finish line. During the competition, the athletes will be notified by the judge. They will have to take out from their boat straight after the finish line on the left bank. To access the equipment control they will have to pass in the channel under the sport

<u>Timing on competition days</u>: open 1h before the 1st boat starts.




Kayak Cross: pre-competition checking

Final phases: the athlete must go straight to Kiss & Cry. Boat and equipment will be brought to the equipment control under an ITO supervision. After the control, boat and equipment will be stored in a specific boat rack at the back of the area. Athlete will be able to reach their equipment from the back.










Anti-doping & Doping control

- Location: first floor of the main building through the tower stairs (point 16 on the map).
- Athletes will be notified for doping control in the finish area.
- Reminder: passport or ID is required
- Anti-doping reminder: ADEL certificate for athletes and coaches








Bib distribution

CSL competition bibs:

- **Competition bib**: be picked up at **the Sport Info Office from** 12:00am on Thursday 5th of June (accreditation fee must be fully paid)
- Training bibs must be given back in exchange of the competition bib
- A 50€ deposit is required at the bib collection (will be returned in exchange of the bib)

Kayak Cross bibs:

- For Kayak Cross Individual, bibs will be picked up at the Sport Info Office from 08:00am to 04:00pm on Saturday 7th of June
- For **Elimination phases**, the numbered and colored bibs will be distributed individually at the start area.





Pre-start procedure

There will be a clock, facing into the lake warm-up area showing race time and the next athletes to start.

CANOE & KAYAK EVENTS

Start procedure

- The starting boat must be alongside the pontoon in front of the partners' panel.
- The beam line is on the dropping line.
- Athletes may move to the start position once the previous Athlete has broken the beam but must be at the start position 15 seconds before their start.






KAYAK CROSS EVENTS

Pre-start procedure

- The path to the pre-start area are:
 - By the island through the small channel (purple)
 - Via the conveyors channel (yellow)
- Access to start ramp will be from the left bank, on the island.





KAYAK CROSS EVENTS

Start procedure

At the start, boat sterns must be aligned with a black a rope stretched across the back of the platform.

Kayak Cross Individual

- Athletes must start from lane 3 on the platform for the Time Trials (third lane from river right)
- The start interval is 60 seconds; athletes should get in their boat on the platform. There will be volunteers to assist them if needed.
- The start time for Kayak Cross Individual will be triggered by photocell.

Elimination phases

- Athletes should be settled in the start position on the ramp 90 seconds before their start time. There will be volunteers to assist them if needed.
- They should then listen to the sports presentation where they will be introduced to spectators.





Finish procedure for canoe kayak events and kayak cross

• The finish beam is marked by the **two yellow flags on the bank**.

The results of the World Cup n°1 will act as the African Reference race to be eligible to enter at the World Championships 2025 as per the rule n°13.4.3 for Canoe, Kayak, and Kayak Cross.

The Kayak Cross African Reference race will be organized with the 4 best African athletes from the Kayak Cross Individual phase.
