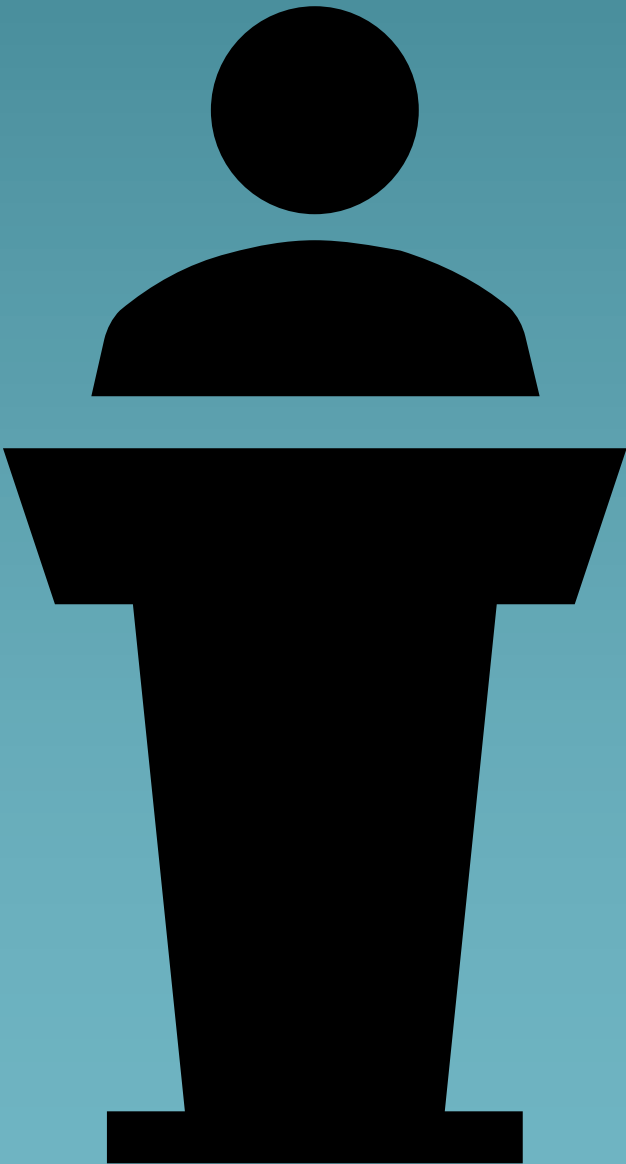

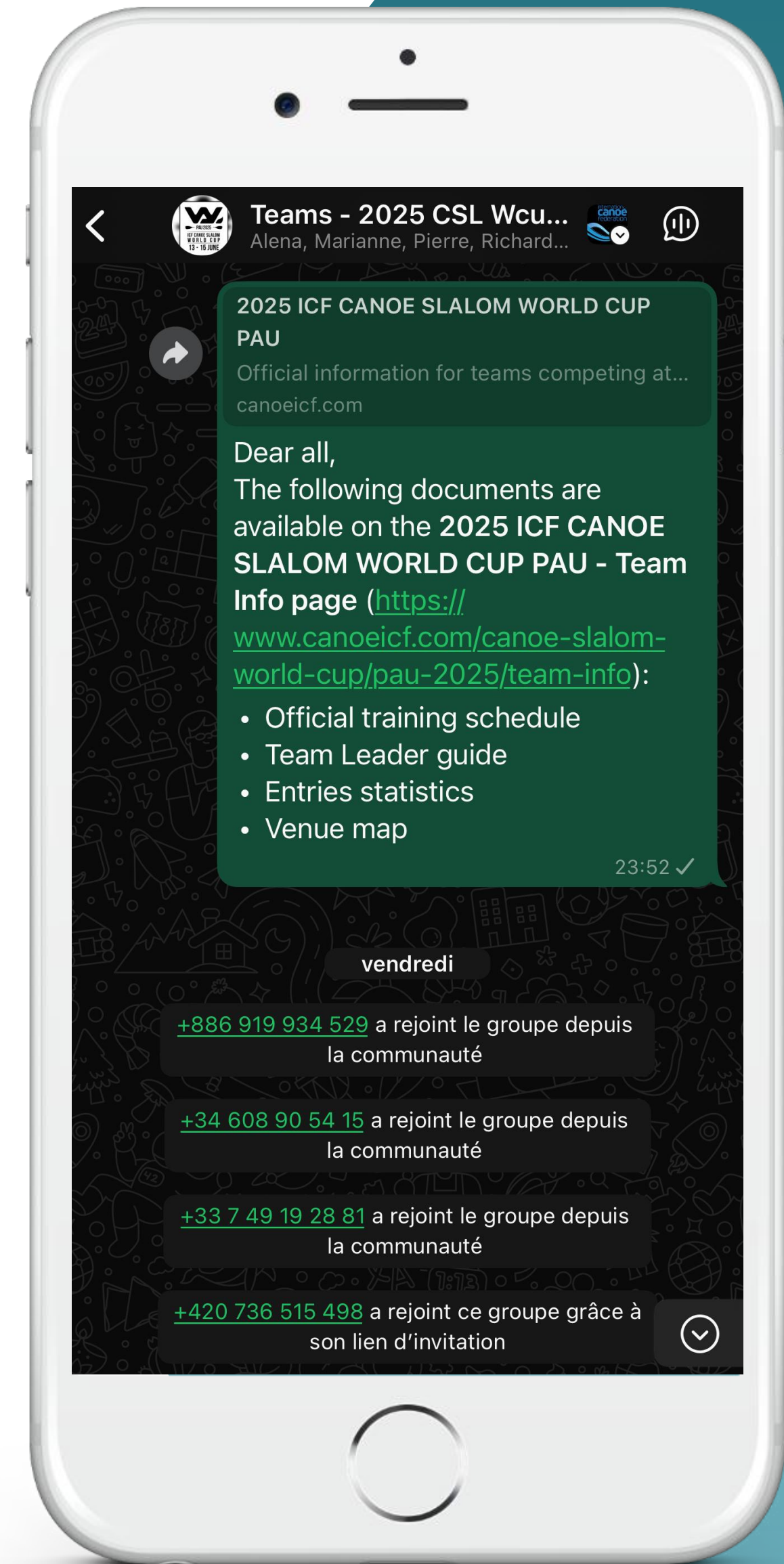

  - **ALL athletes must shoot a new headshot** (not only for new ones)
  - Athletes must wear their **dry competition gear**.

# Equipment control

- **Location**: Equipment Control is located on the **river right after the finish line**. During the competition, the athletes will be **notified by the judge**. They will have to **take out from their boat straight after the finish line on the right bank (grey pontoon)**.
- **Self-checking**: Wednesday 11th June from 9am to 6.30pm and Thursday 12th June from 8am to 7.30 pm
- **Timing on competition days**: open 1h before the 1<sup>st</sup> boat starts.
- **Reminder**:
  - **Canoe & Kayak events and Kayak Cross Individual**: post competition control and random checking
  - **Kayak Cross**: pre-competition checking in the pre-start area
  - **Final phases**: the athlete must go **straight to Kiss & Cry**. The boat can be left in the ITO hands in the Equipment Control tent. After the control, boat and equipment will be **stored in a specific boat rack at the back of the area**. Athlete will be able to reach their equipment from the back.

# Anti-doping & Doping Control

- **Location:** ground floor of the main building
- Athletes will be notified for doping control in the finish area.
- **Reminder:** passport or ID is required
- Anti-doping reminder: ADEL certificate for athletes and coaches

# Kiss & Cry

- Location: in front of the enquiry desk
- For **Canoe and Kayak Finals**:
  - Provisional **top 3** at the Kiss and Cry
  - With bib and competition gear
- For **Kayak Cross Individual**:
  - Provisional top 3 at the Kiss and Cry only **for the last 10 athletes**
  - With bib and competition gear (warm clothes accepted)

  - For **Kayak Cross Individual**: after the run of the event

# Official training schedule

- Canoe slalom training sessions start **on Monday until Thursday**
- Kayak Cross training sessions take place on **Wednesday, Thursday** and on **Saturday**.
- Exact timings and updates are available on the **online official training schedule**.





# Competition schedule

- The course is closed following the end of official training (Thursday 12.06.2025 at 19:30) until the end of the competition.
- The competition schedule version 3 will be available on the dedicated ICF event Team Info webpage on Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> of June by 10am and spread on the WhatsApp Group.
- New: during the Canoe and Kayak Heats, **start interval is different for the 20 last bibs of each event – 90 seconds.**

# Bib distribution

## CSL competition bibs:

- **Competition bib:** be picked up at the **Team Leader lounge** from on **Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> of June after the last training session** (accreditation fee must be fully paid)
- All training bibs need to be brought at the same time after last training, in exchange of competition bib. Last training kayak cross training will be allowed without training bib.
- The 50€ deposit per nation paid at training bib pick-up will be kept for competition bib – **cash only**

## Kayak Cross bibs:

- For **Kayak Cross Individual**, bibs will be picked up at the **Team Leader Lounge** from 1.45pm to 5pm on **Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> of June** in exchange of Canoe & Kayak bibs. Each nation must return all the bibs at the same time.
- For **Elimination phases**, the numbered bibs will be distributed at the **Team Leader Lounge** in exchange of the Kayak Cross Individual bibs and colored bibs will be distributed **individually at the start area**.





# CANOE & KAYAK EVENTS

## Pre-start procedure

There will be a clock in the start pool (red circle) showing the competition time and the next athletes to start.





# CANOE & KAYAK EVENTS

## Start procedure

- The starting boat must be alongside the pontoon in front of the partners' panel, facing downstream.
- The beam line is on the dropping line.
- Athletes may move to the start position once the previous athlete has broken the beam but must be at the start position 15 seconds before their start.





# CANOE & KAYAK EVENTS

## Finish procedure

- The finish beam is marked by the panel “Finish” hanged on the top, across the water.
- All athletes must exit **on the right bank via the pontoon located after the finish line.**





# KAYAK CROSS EVENTS

## Pre-start procedure

- Access to start ramp will be **from the right bank, on the island.**
- Athletes go through pre-start equipment control and pick up their coloured bib





# KAYAK CROSS EVENTS

## Start procedure

At the start, boat sterns will be aligned by assistant starter with white panel on the floor.

### ➤ Kayak Cross Individual

- Athletes must start from **lane 3** on the platform for the Time Trials (**second lane from river left**)
- The start interval is **60 seconds**; **athletes should get in their boat on the platform**. There will be volunteers to assist them if needed.

### ➤ Elimination phases

- Athletes should be settled in the start position on the ramp 90 seconds before their start time. There will be volunteers to assist them if needed.
- They should then listen to the sports presentation where they will be introduced to spectators.





# KAYAK CROSS EVENTS

## Finish procedure

- The finish line will be 50 meters upstream from CSL one.
- All athletes must exit **on the right bank via the pontoon located after the finish line.**



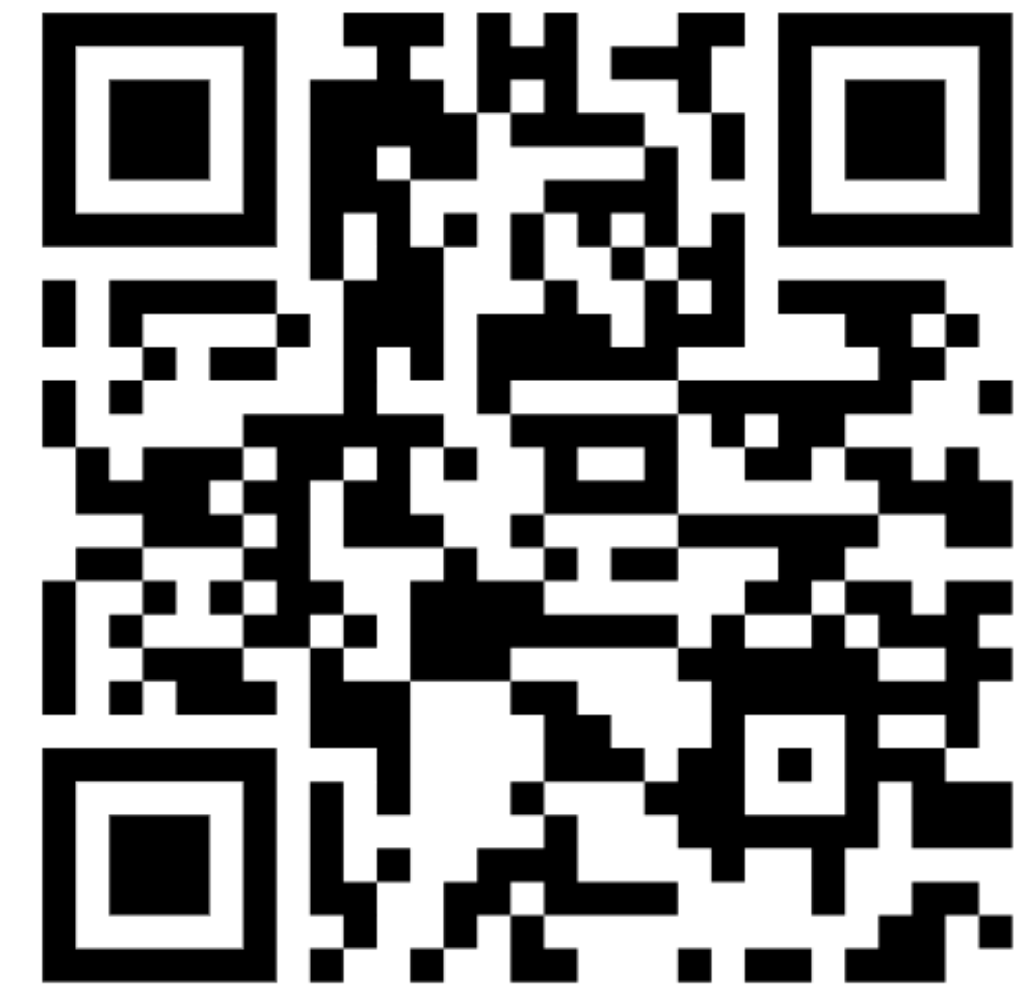
