

The HOC of the Marathon World Championships aims to offer young athletes a racing opportunity that resembles traditional marathon events but in a more playful and engaging format. Therefore, as part of the event, MK1–MK2 and MC1–PC2 relay races will be organised.

September 7 (Sunday)


The course will traverse the Mosoni-Duna and the city centre of Győr, combining sections through natural landscapes with those in an urban setting.

The start, finish, and portage areas will all be located in the same vicinity. Competitors will start from a pontoon, with boat-holders assigned to assist each participant. A 100-meter portage will be situated along the riverbank near the finish line. Both ends of the portage will feature sandy beaches for disembarkation and embarkation, eliminating the need for pontoons. The portage area will be clearly delineated with barriers and marked with red and yellow indicators at the disembarkation and embarkation points. The portage will be wide enough to accommodate at least four K2 boats simultaneously.


Electronic timing will be used, with participants carrying chips, and a photo-finish camera with video recording will be installed at the finish line.








PARACANOE COURSE





VISA

Participants who require assistance with the visa application process are kindly asked to initiate the procedure as soon as possible by following the steps outlined below. The process of obtaining a visa for Hungary can vary depending on the region, so it is advisable to allow for a 45-day processing period to ensure timely issuance.

THE TYPICAL STEPS FOR OBTAINING A VISA ARE AS FOLLOWS:

- Booking accommodation via the HOC or sending the confirmation of your hotel booking to the HOC (if booked individually) - please note, the HOC cannot take responsibility for rejection of visa issuance
- Sending the filled-in visa application form to the HOC (booking@gyor2025.com)
- 3. The HOC issues the Letter of Invitation
- 4. Contacting the Hungarian Embassy / Consulate serving in your country / territory and do the paperwork they request from you
- 5. Visa issuance

Please be informed that the HOC will not issue an invitation letter without knowing your team's arrival and departure dates,

accommodation details, the number of participants and their identities. The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Hungary and the respective embassy or consulate require the same information from us, therefore, we cannot support your request without your cooperation in providing this information.



Classification of paracanoe athletes will take place at the competition area between September 1-2 (Monday-Tuesday). The dedicated paracanoe pontoon will be installed for the exclusive use of paracanoe athletes during the classification period. For further relevant details please see page 5 of the Para Canoe Bulletin #1 published by the ICF.
