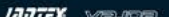

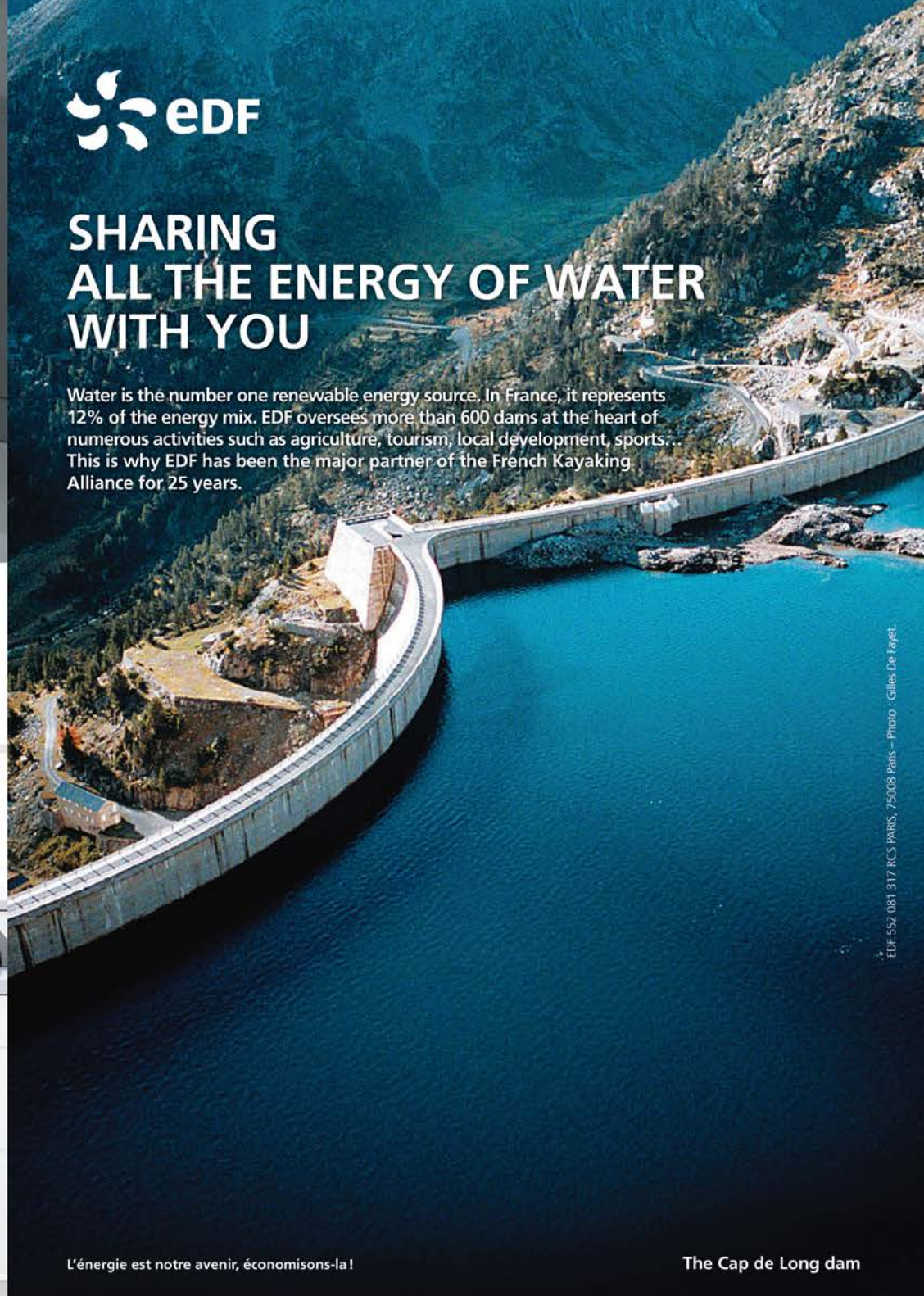

Canoe Slalom French Team

In Canoe Slalom, there is a certain advantage to compete at home. The hours of training and the number of participation in a competition are criteria of undeniable performances.

This advantage is particularly visible at the time of World Cups stages, where it is not rare to see the welcoming teams realizing the best performances of the competition.

It was the case in Pau in 2009, 2012 and 2015 with not less than 5 medals: 2 gold ones drop out by Pierre-Antoine TILLARD in canoe single men and Emilie FER in kayak women, 1 silver picked up by the crew made up of Gauthier KLAUSS and Matthieu PECHE in two-seater canoe men and 2 bronze medals with Denis GARGAUD-CHANUT in canoe single men and PRIGENT / KERVELLA in two-seater canoe men.

The stage of World Cup in Pau 2016 will have the same objective as that of 2015. Mark the international competition only one and a half month before the Olympics of Rio. Indeed, as in 2015, the Pau stage of the world cup 2016 will be the last competition before the main term of the year.

Finally, the World Championship 2017 will come to close this chain of competition on the Pau Whitewater stadium. Paddlers' generation will be eager to end its career at home on their Olympic training for Rio 2016 and a new generation will wish to lean on Pau 2017 to dash towards Tokyo 2020.

It can only promise excellent results for the French team.

> CANOE SLALOM, WHAT IS IT?

Canoe Slalom is an Olympic discipline which consists on doing the most rapidly a wild water course of almost 400 meters length by respecting mandatory passages, indicated by doors (18 to 25 maximum). There are two types of doors:

- > **Green doors: to cross towards the downstream**
- > **Red doors: to push up towards the upstream**

The touched doors or not crossed ones, counting as penalties, which add themselves to final, score (2 seconds for a touch, 50 seconds for a missed door).

International categories :

- > **Kayak single men (K1M) and women (K1W),**
- > **Canoe single men (C1M) and women (C1W),**
- > **Double place canoe men (C2M).**

It exists also team events (team of three boats from the same category).

People practice canoe slalom on whitewater courses, more or less complicated, depending on the competition level, with a heat in two runs, followed by a semi-final and a final.

SLALOM CROSS, WHAT IS IT?

This is a new event, part of discipline Canoe Slalom, who is currently emerging at the international stage.

It consists of a knock-out tournament between four athletes per round, competing on a five to seven-gate slalom course.

The competition starts from a three to five-meter ramp above the river, which can be highly spectacularly. The competition duration is very fast, it lasts between 45 and 60 seconds. Athletes have to go down the course and cross obstacles.

Boats, which are used, are hybrid between Canoe Slalom boats and extreme kayak races boats.

The International Canoe Federation is currently working on rules writing and this new event will be present in 2016 at some Canoe Slalom World Cup stage, like in Pau in June.

> WILDWATER CANOEING, WHAT IS IT?

The rule is simple: go as quickly as possible of a point upstream to another point downstream to the river. It is a race against the clock, being practised in white waters where it is essential to choose well its trajectory according to the streams and the natural obstacles which form rocks. The races take place mainly on natural courses, however with the emergence of sprint the competitions begin to get organized on the same places as canoe slalom. There are two types of races: the classic competition with a duration from 12 to 25 min and the sprint competition with a duration from 30 seconds to 2 min 30.

ICF CANOE WORLD CUP, WHAT IS IT?

This is a racing circuit on which competitors score points. An overall ranking takes into account the results of the different stages until the final.

The 5 stages of 2016 ICF Canoe Slalom World Cup:

- > 1: 3rd to 5th June 2016, Ivrea, Italy
- > 2: 10th to 12th June 2016, La Seu d'Urgell, Spain
- > 3: 16th to 19th June 2016, Pau, France
- > 4: 2nd to 4th September 2016, Prague, Czech Republic
- > Final: 9th to 11th September 2016, Tacen, Slovenia

The 3 stages of the 2016 ICF Wildwater Canoeing World Cup:

- > Step 1 and 2: 9th to 11th June 2016, Celje, Slovenia
- > Final: 16th to 19th June 2016, Pau, France

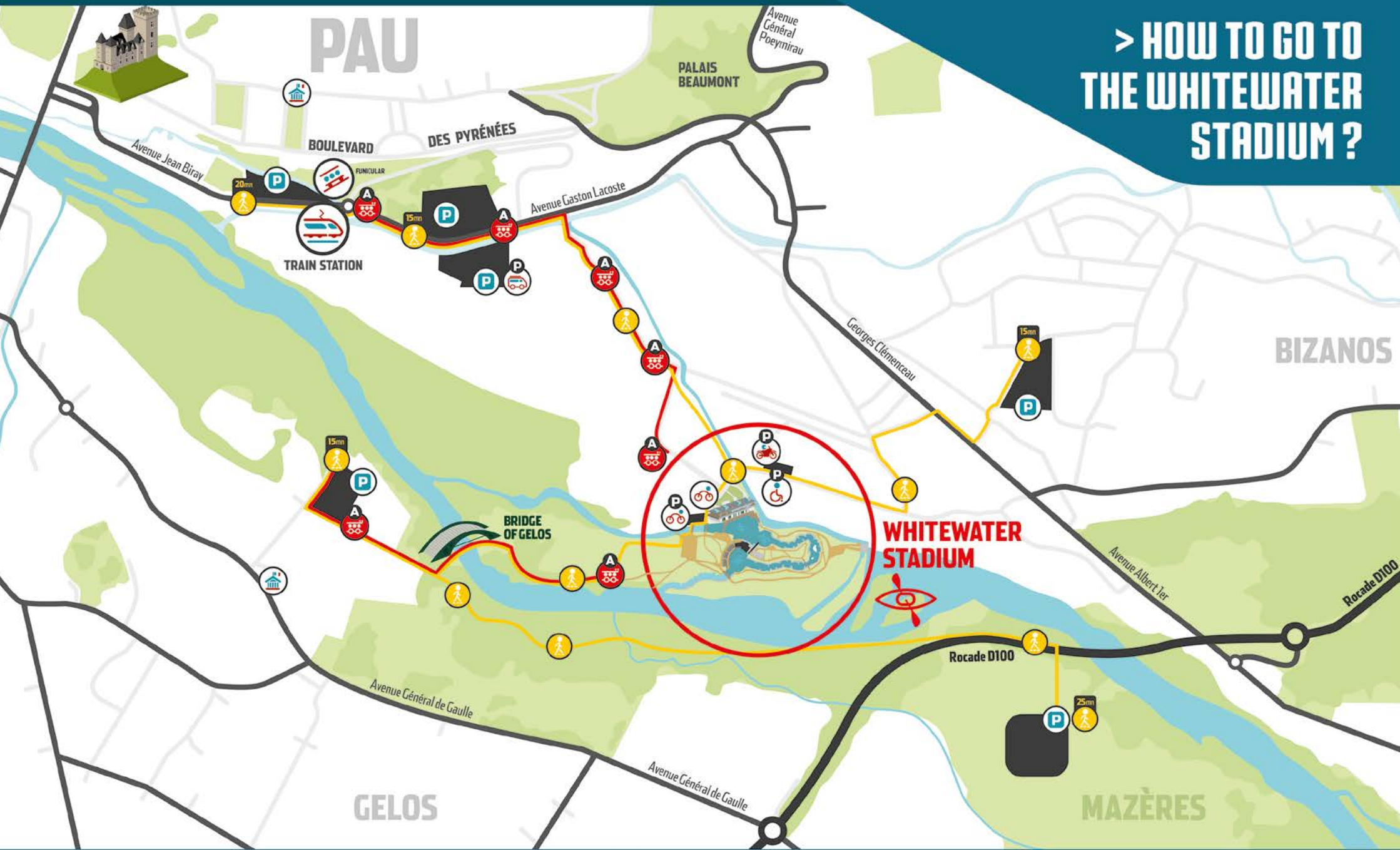
