Venue: Lake Santa Caterina, Auronzo di Cadore

All participants of the competition must be accredited. No access is possible to the race venue without an accreditation card.

The Coach and/or Team Leader of participating teams should come to the Accreditation centre at the venue, Pala TreCime Sport Center, (google maps 46.550549, 12.436314), which is located next to the football field.

Please bring the original passports or ID cards of all your group (ID card only for the countries of the European Union) to the Accreditation staff. Passports should be in alphabetical order and photocopies provided (these should be left with the staff).

You will not be accredited unless all dues have been paid. After which the team leaders may collect the necessary documents and body numbers.

Before leaving the Accreditation Centre, team leaders will be asked to:

- listen to your country anthem, check your flag and sign that they are correct
- check and sign departure information
- leave their and their team's head coach's phone numbers so they can be reached at any time during the competition
- nominate 1/2 team members for flag and sign for opening parade.

There will be a cost of Euro 10,00 for every pass that needs to be reprinted if lost, damaged or forgotten in the hotel.

Acceptable methods of payment: cash (€euro), credit card (Visa / Mastercard)





MEALS

Please note that the first meal will be the first following your arrival - it could be at the designated hotel OR at the catering area depending on the time of arrival and the accommodation package confirmed. You will be provided with all the info during check in by our staff. Lunches will always be served at the catering area at the race venue.

In case hotels don't serve breakfast from 06.00am, this service will be guaranteed at the catering area at the Regatta course.

Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner at the Regatta Course will be served in the catering tent on a ticket-based system from the next day of your arrival. Lunch tickets will be given to the Team Leaders upon arrival in the Accreditation Centre.

OFFICIAL HOTELS

Check-in: from 14:00 Check-out: until 10:00

Upon arrival at the hotel, one of our staff will be waiting to greet you and assist the team with the check-in, meal times etc. This person will be available to assist your team throughout your stay in Auronzo. Their available times will be communicated at your arrival.

The Organising Committee does not take any responsibility for any extra services consumed or used at the hotel, such as mini-bar, telephone etc: these costs are to be paid directly to the hotel. Any damages caused to the rooms at any time must be paid immediately to the hotel.

For teams who have not organised transfers but are coming with their own transport, please advise our booking department (accommodation@auronzo2023.com) of your estimated arrival time so that the hostess can be at the hotel to greet you.

LUGGAGE STORAGE

For teams departing on Sunday 9th July and need to check out from the hotel, a luggage storage area will be made available at the Accreditation Centre. In this case, the bus transfers to the airports, will depart from Piazza Vigo (to be confirmed before departure).

AIRPORT TRANSFERS

Teams and officials will be met at Venice and/or Treviso airport by a staff member holding a sign with the Championships logo.

At Venice (VCE) airport, after customs control and luggage claim, please exit to the right where you will find one of our volunteers waiting for you (next to the Lost and Found office).

At Treviso (TSF) airport, after customs control and luggage claim, please exit to the right where you will find one of our volunteers waiting for you.

In case assistance is required at the airport, you will be given the contact number of the person who will be waiting for your team at the airport. This will be sent to you before you begin your journey.

TRANSPORT and PARKING

Timetables will be comunicated in a separate document and via a whatsapp group.

Shuttle buses will be running on a regular basis between the regatta venue and the official hotels. The pick-up and drop-off is located in Piazza Vigo (about 300mt from the athlete's area).

The shuttle timetables will be handed out in the coaches during the trip from the airport to Auronzo and will also be placed in each hotel.

Please wear your accreditation pass to board the shuttle bus.

Each team will receive only one parking pass for a van or car regardless of the number of people on the team. Vans/cars must park in the allocated Team Car Park located near the ice-skating rink and Via Trieste, close to the athletes tent area (google maps 46.5504831737485, 12.443108098766992).

No vehicle will be allowed into the race venue.

BUSES: All buses MUST park at Taiarezze or at their hotel parking areas. Team buses will be permitted stop to pick-up and drop off teams at Piazza Vigo (200mt from the race venue) and must then IMMEDIATELY proceed to the parking area. No standing will be permitted in Piazza Vigo. Buses will not be permitted to come into the race venue.

PARKING FOR SUPPORTERS

In an effort to minimise traffic congestion in Auronzo, an interchange car park will be provided at Cima Gogna (5 minutes south of Auronzo) and at Taiarezze (ski-slopes – about 2km from the race venue) free of charge where supporters can leave their vehicles. A free shuttle services will run between continously between these two parking areas and Auronzo's central Piazza Vigo where people can then access the lake by foot. This service will be fully operational from July 4 (on July 3 the service will run on a reduced service).

A schedule will be made available as soon as it is ready.

INFO POINT

An Info Desk for the Team Leaders will be located close to the beginning of the bridge. Each team will received the initial information package at the Accreditation Centre upon arrival. During the competition, staff at the Info Point will provide all the necessary information in regards to the competition.







CREW CHANGE

Please, find the online version of the form in the appendix. Printed forms can be picked at the Competition Information Centre onsite. Forms should be submitted via email to the Chief Official, Mr Jens Kahl at jens.kahl@kanu.de and Mr Marcos Oliveira (Memosoft) at marcos.fpc@gmail.com and in copy Alison Harris alison.harris@canoeicf.sport. Only forms submitted up until the dead-line will be accepted. After the deadline you need to contact the Chief Official directly.

DEADLINE TO SUBMIT THE FORMS: 03rd July, 18:00.

- 1. Any athlete named in the final entry of his/her country may substitute in any other event.
- 2. Notification of alterations of the entries must be given/submitted in written form to the Chief Official at least one (1) hour before the first race of the morning or afternoon session.
- 3. The withdrawal of an entry is considered final and the same athlete/crew is not allowed to compete in any other events of the competition.
- 4. In extraordinary circumstances, an application can be made to the Technical Chair for the acceptance of late nominal entries from National Federations. It is the Technical Chair's discretion to accept or decline a late entry. Late entries will incur a fee of 50 euros per athlete.

DEADLINE TO SUBMIT THE FORMS: 03rd July, 18:00.

MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

The following medical services are available for all accredited participants of the Championships: doctor on duty, hospital and clinic assistance.

The medical services will operate at the regatta course with ambulance and first aid. The costs above the regular first aid and ambulance services are to be covered by your medical insurance policy. The Organising Committee is not responsible to cover your expenses (hospital treatment, dental treatment or ay other medical treatment).









BOAT STORAGE

Boat racks are provided in the Athlete's Area.

PLEASE NOTE: The area dedicated to the boat racks is subject to side winds. We recommend that BOATS ARE SECURED/TIED TO THE RACKS before leaving the venue at the end of your races. Trailers are to be parked in the designated parking area.

BOAT NUMBERS AND BODY NUMBERS

The body numbers are to be worn during the entire duration of the competition and can be collected by the team leader at the accreditation.

The BOAT NUMBER can be collected one hour before the competition at the designated place next to ID control (see map).

ID CONTROL

The competitors can embark only from the designated area before the competition where their body numbers, boat numbers and accreditation cards are checked.

SELF BOAT CONTROL

Two scales will be available for athletes before the start of the competition.

Tuesday 04th July 08:00 - 13:00 14:00 - 17:00

SECOND (POST RACE) BOAT CONTROL

This is located opposite the finish tower, close the tribune (grandstands). After the race, the competitors will be called to the second boat control and must disembark onto the designated pontoon.

DOPING CONTROL

The selected competitors are subject to doping control conforming to the relevant regulations at the designated place.

ITO's MEETING

OPENING CEREMONY

Date: Tuesday 04th July 18:00-18:45

Location: Piazza Santa Giustina

17:00 – gathering of teams at the Race Venue next to the Athlete's area and preparation for the Opening Ceremony Parade.

Teams will line up in alphabetical order by Nation (volunteers will be present to assist).

Please indicate 2 team members to hold the flag and nations sign for the parade and ceremony during accreditation.

At 17:30 – team will parade from the lake, through the town centre to Piazza Santa Giustina where the Opening Ceremony will take place.

CYCLING AT THE VENUE

The narrow, winding walking trail located next to the lake is a **public area** and used by many pedestrians and children.

As per the Local Council Regulation (and indicated by a street sign on the trail) IT IS FORBIDDEN to ride bicycles on this trail between 9:00am and 6:00pm.

TEAM TENTS

Teams have been allocated gazebos in the athlete's area and are placed directly on grass. The tents do not have a hard surface, so you may like to consider bringing a waterproof blanket or cover.

If a team wishes to bring their own tent, they can do so. There is enough space to place it next to the gazebo allocated to their team.





INTERNET

Wireless internet service will be available in the vicinity of the race venue free of charge. Access details will be available at the Accreditation area.

BOAT AND PERSONAL NUMBERS

The personal (bib) numbers to be worn during the whole duration of the competition will be collected by the Team leader during the accreditation process. The boat numbers can be collected immediately before the race at the designated place right next to the ID control. All boat number must be returned directly after the race to the organisation either to a volunteer at the exit pontoons or at a boat distribution tent (before ID control).

A deposit of Euro 20 will be required upon collecting the start numbers for the long distance races and/or relays. This will be refunded once the numbers have all been returned.

BOAT STICKERS

The country code and athlete's name stickers on the boats are HIGLY RECCOMMENDED. It is the participating National Federations' responsibility to provide the stickers to their athletes. There will be no possibility to print those at the venue.

MEDAL CEREMONIES

The Medal ceremonies will be held following the finals as per the race program. Athletes should come to the area dedicated to the ceremonies dressed in their national team uniforms **15 minutes before** their ceremony.

To maintain the formality of the ceremony the athletes receiving medals MUST wear their national team uniform and proper footwear and should come to the dedicated area 15 minutes before their ceremony.

No Flags, caps or sunglasses are allowed at the podium.

Medal ceremonies will start at their officially scheduled time. In case any athlete arrives late to the meeting point, ceremony will start by the schedule without him/her.

On the Sunday, the medal ceremonies will be held after each 5000m race. The change area for the athletes will be located next to the second boat control. Team Leaders or coaches are required to bring the national team uniform and shoes to this area. Athletes should should remain in this area until they are ready to be accompanied to the podium, together with the team leader of the winning nation.





DRINKING WATER

Auronzo has fresh, clean drinking water.

There are water fountains located around the lake that provide clear, fresh drinking water – one of these is located within the athlete's area, one is located near the Info Point and one is located close the finish tower. So in respect of the environment and in an effort to decrease the amount of plastic waste, our sponsor CMP has provided each participant with 1 aluminum water bottle (1500 pieces, while stocks last). We ask you to kindly use these fountains, either refilling the aluminum water bottle provided or using your own water bottles.

DRONE USAGE

Private drone usage above and around the lake and in all areas of the race venue is **NOT PERMITTED** as the event will be filmed using the TV company's drones, and any other non-authorised drones may create a safety hazard.


