Toshi FURUYA started his career as athlete in 1982, then he became the head coach of prefectural canoe sprint team towards national sports festival in his prefecture. After the successful results in national sports festival, he started to be involved in national junior team of Japan. He also coached many top junior athletes in his high school.

He has since worked with many of Japan's top canoeists, including Asian Games gold medalists and Olympians, and was the High Performance Director of the Japan Canoe Federation from 2008 to 2012.

He has worked as a member of the International Canoe Federation (ICF) Canoe Sprint committee, a role he began in 2000. He has worked as an International Technical Official (ITO) at the past four Olympic Summer Games and he has worked as Canoe Sport Manager both for Canoe Sprint & Paracanoe in Tokyo 2020.

Toshi FURUYA is now the ICF Canoe Sprint Committee Chair and the ICF Executive Board Member. He has successfully concluded the Paris 2024 Olympic Games as the Technical Delegate and already started developing LA28.

He is also Secretary General of the Japan Canoe Federation and Executive Board Member of Japanese Olympic Committee.
