With great pleasure, I would like to announce my candidacy for the position of Vice President of the International Canoe Federation.

I have been involved in canoeing since my early childhood as the third generation of a canoeing family with a significant background. My grandfather introduced canoeing to our city. My father - Martin was a national athlete for Czechoslovakia and has over 20 years of involvement as an official in Slovak Canoeing and other Slovak sports organisations. He is currently the Vice-President of Slovak Canoeing and Chairman of the Whitewater section. My uncle - Miroslav was an Olympian in Atlanta 1996 and Vice European Champion. My cousin - Sona is a Canoe Slalom U23 World Champion and multiple Canoe Slalom medalist, and my brother - Jakub is a medalist in junior and U23 events. My top achievement as an athlete is a silver medal in Kayak Cross at the World Cup in 2020, following several medal achievements in Canoe Slalom international events.

Since my teenage years, I have been engaged in various projects, ranging from private business activities to voluntary and leadership roles in sports organisations. I have had the opportunity to experience all positions in canoeing and have broad experience in organising international canoeing events. Although I was initially perceived as one of the youngest officials, I have always been able to turn this into an opportunity to bring new visions for our sport's development at all levels, thanks to my education, personal and business experience. I have been successfully involved in the development of a youth venue for all canoeing disciplines in Slovakia. Currently, I'm co-leading one of the biggest venue projects for all canoeing disciplines in the world.

Outside the world of canoeing, I have extensive experience in the creation and implementation of development and investment projects for municipalities as well as private companies.

We have a huge opportunity to grow our community, strengthen relationships between national federations, build sustainable canoeing infrastructure and development projects, empower women in our sport, enhance leisure and tourism potential, introduce new educational programs, and take advantage of modern marketing strategies and AI technologies to promote all Olympic and non-Olympic canoeing disciplines across all continents.

The paddling community consists of several million enthusiastic athletes and tourists worldwide who enjoy following the performances of the best in the elite sphere of canoeing. Canoeing is the most beautiful sport, and together we can create one of the leading global sports federations. It would be a great pleasure for me to face future common challenges and to help promote canoeing and ICF values all over the world.
