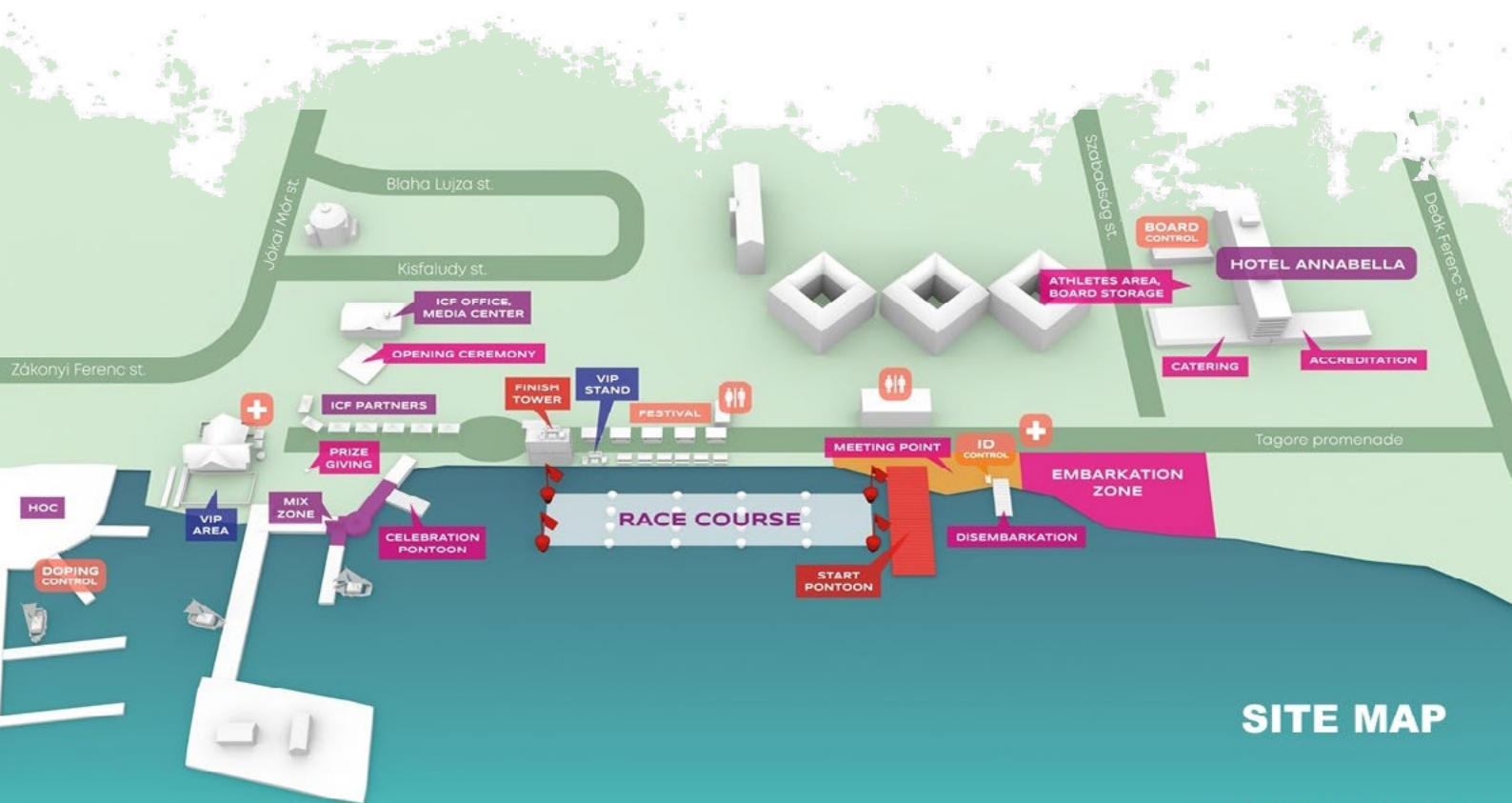

Athletes are kindly requested to contact the accreditation centre directly upon arrival. All the athletes are required to present a valid passport to prove their country of citizenship and age.

All participants of the competition must be accredited. No access is possible to the accredited areas and racecourse without an accreditation card.

Accreditation package includes the followings:

- ID card
- BIB singlet (only for athletes)
- lunch tickets (optional)
- T-shirt (optional)
- water tickets
- board security sticker (only for athletes)

The information centre for the athletes is located in the accreditation centre, as well.

Official Hotel

Drinking Water supply

In order to protect the environment the Organising Committee provides 1.5 l bottled water / day during access period for accredited participants. You can pick them up at the Embarkation Area by presenting the water ticket.

Board Storage and Athletes area

Athletes area and board storage are located in the backyard of the official hotel. You can enter the area by presenting a valid accreditation card. The security service can check the sups based on the board security sticker. Please use the Board Storage and Athletes Area for rest and board storage during the break between races.

Athletes briefing

Online athletes briefing will be held on each competition day via Zoom. Time will be announced later. Meeting invitation will be sent to the email address submitted in the entry system.

Pre-race Board control

All athletes need to present their board(s) at board control before the race. Board control is located in the backyard of the official hotel. Officials will check that the board complies with the ICF competition rules and validate them with putting a sticker on it. The presence of the sticker will be checked by the ID control during the race. You can't start the race without it. Officials will place the BIB sticker on your board at the same time.

Official Training sessions

The official technical and sprint courses are available for training on the 8th of September between **9:00-12:00** and **13:00-17:00**. Water rescue will be on duty during the official training session.

Id Control

All athletes must pass ID control before each race. At this point officials will check the competitor's eligibility to take part in the race.

The conditions for compliance are as follows:

- Proof of personal identification with your accreditation card
- You have to wear your BIB singlet
- Board validated by the officials
- BIB number stuck to the correct place on the board
- Adequacy and availability of safety equipment

THE CORRECT PLACE FOR BIB NUMBER- STICKER ON YOUR BOARD

BIB number sticker must be placed on the right side- in front of your board maximum 40cm from the top of the board. Sticker must be placed on a flat area, it needs

to be readable from the side. Athletes with incorrectly placed stickers will be disqualified.

You will receive your BIB number sticker from boat control officials.



Safety equipment

Athletes must ensure they have the listed mandatory equipment.

LONG-DISTANCE AND INFLATABLE EVENTS

- certificated buoyancy aid vest or PFD belt is mandatory, life jacket is recommended for those with less experience
- safety leash is mandatory

SPRINT AND TECHNICAL EVENTS

- buoyancy aid vest, PFD belt or life jacket is recommended but not mandatory
- safety leash is recommended

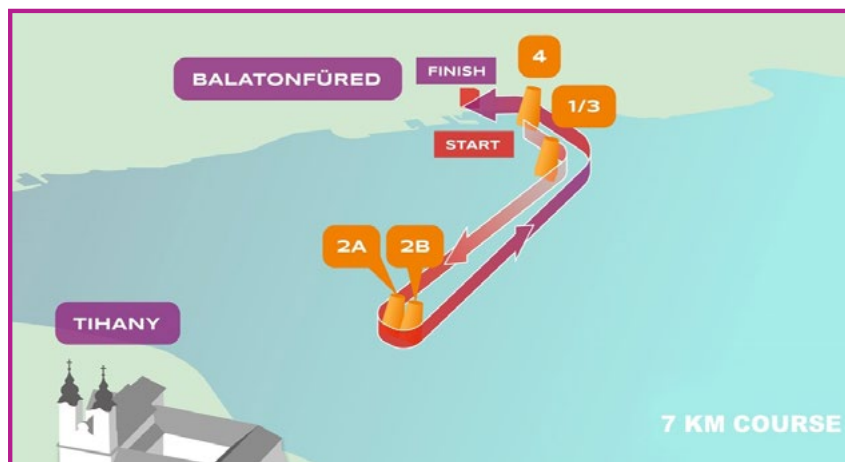


Events and courses

INFLATABLE EVENT

There are no age group categories, only male and female races. The course is set on the Balatonfüred - Tihany - Balatonfüred 7 km route. The race will start in groups from the starting line parallel to the Tagore promenade.

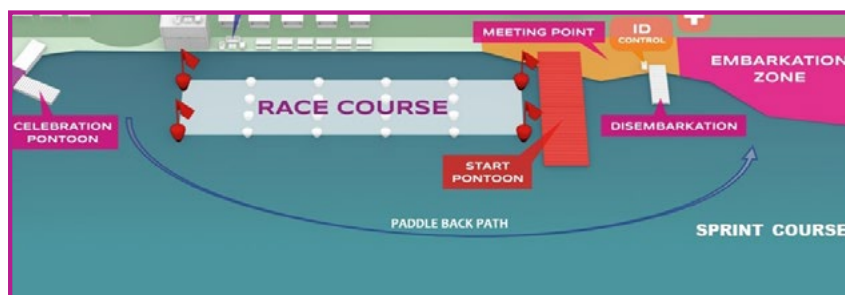
Inflatable course



SPRINT EVENT

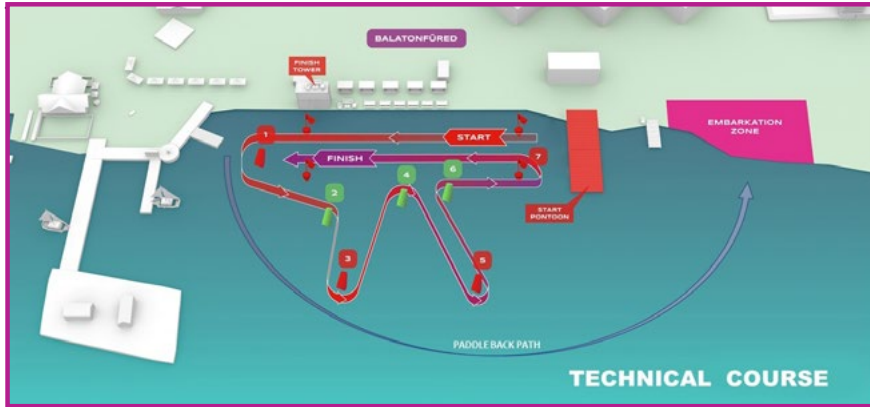
The sprint race will take place directly in front of the Tagore promenade, on a 200 m straight course marked out with buoys. In each heat, 8 competitors will start in a line, side by side. The competition will be organised on a qualification basis. There will be stationary water start. The position of the boards at the start is such that the noses of the competing boards are on the starting line. The boards may be held at the tail by board holders.

Sprint course



TECHNICAL EVENT

Competitors have to go around a total of 7 zigzag buoys on a 1,000 m course. The course is marked directly in front of the Tagore promenade. In each heat, 8 competitors will start in a line, side by side. The competition will be organised on a qualification basis. There will be stationary water start. The position of the boards at the start is such that the noses of the competing boards are on the starting line. The boards may be held at the tail by board holders. There will be no portage.



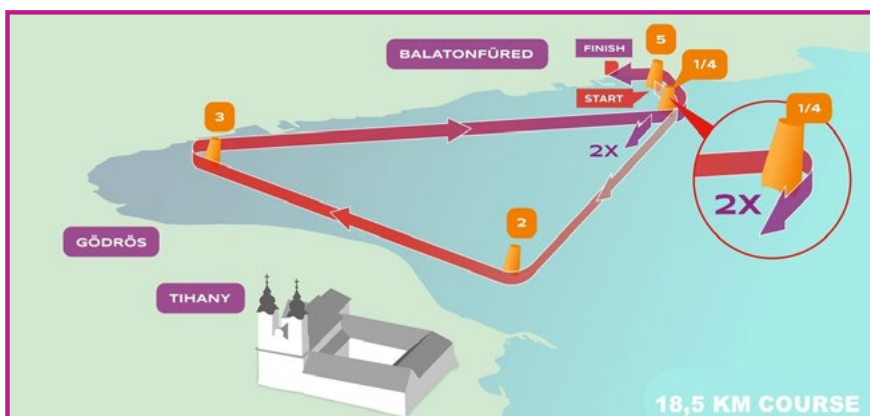
LONG-DISTANCE EVENT

Each age group competes on courses of different lengths. The courses will be marked in the area bordered by Balatonfüred - Tihany - Gödrös. There are no heats for the long-distance races, so all participants will compete in the final race. All competitor will start in a group from the start line parallel to the Tagore Promenade. There will be no portage.

Pre-race procedure for sprint and technical races

This procedure is part of the sport presentation elements. Please follow the steps to make our sport more enjoyable for TV audience.

1. Athletes must appear at the designated ID control area on the shore, not later than 10 minutes before the actual race starts. ID control area is accessible from both water and shore.
2. After passing ID control, athletes have to line up at the meeting point according to their starting position.
3. Under the command of the marshals, athletes will march onto the starting pontoon one by one with the board in their hands.

Sport Presentation

The following instructions apply only to Final A units.

All FINAL „A” medallists (1-3) must disembark on the pontoon (called: celebration pontoon) located in front of the finish line. There will be a display on the finish tower which will show the first three finishing athlete.

First three must paddle to the celebration pontoon, all the others have to return to the Athletes Area.

DISEMBARKATION ON THE CELEBRATION PONTOON:

Short interviews by the ICF TV will be recorded right after disembarkation where trainers/family members can greet the medalists at first hand.



Prize Money

A total of gross 30.000EUR will be divided between the Open Long-distance, Technical and Sprint race medallists as follows:

Traffic regulation during race days

There is one way traffic on the water. Athletes are requested to paddle back to the Embarkation Area straight after their race. The race course must be bypassed from the water side according to the instructions of the motorboat personnel. After the finish of the long-distance races, the athletes must paddle back to the Embarkation Area close to the shore. Meanwhile, disturbing those still in the race is strictly forbidden.

Safety regulations on water

Technical and sprint races are held on a course closed to boat traffic, while long-distance and inflatable races are held on a race course which is open to boat traffic. The route of the long-distance competition may be crossed by boats which the competitor has an obligation to give way. There is a storm warning system in the whole area of Lake Balaton. A strong flashing yellow light

FIRST LEVEL STORM WARNING

In the case of a first level storm warning, the wind is expected to be stronger than 45 km/h, but not exceeding 60 km/h, the storm alarm device will flash 45 minutes per minute. In this case, swimming, using a boat and doing other water sports are only allowed within 500 meters of the shore.

SECOND LEVEL STORM WARNING

In the case of a second level storm warning, a stormy wind of more than 65 km/h is expected, and the storm lights flash 90 times per minute. In this case, they indicate the arrival of the storm in a short time. In that event, bathing is forbidden! It is also forbidden to use boats and other water sports equipment (except sailboats).

In the event of a second level storm warning, the organizers may decide disallow the start of the long-distance races. Inflatable races cannot start in the event of a second level storm warning.

The organizing committee provides a lifeguard service within the guarded area during official training times and on competition days.

Traffic on the lake is applied by the Hungarian Navigation Regulations (Decree 57/2011 NFM) and the Rules for Staying on Free Water (Decree 46/2001 BM).

Doping control

All competitors of the ICF SUP World Championships must pass the relevant anti-doping online course on the Anti-Doping Education Learning platform (ADEL)

According to the ICF rules for the ICF World Championships, ICF World Cups and ICF Ranking Races and Continental Championships, each athlete, coach and support personnel must pass the relevant anti-doping online course on the Anti-Doping Education Learning platform (ADEL) corresponding to their role before the first day of the competition in accordance with 2021 ICF Anti-Doping Rules. Athletes entered in any ICF competition or continental championships must complete the ICF's anti-doping education programme or equivalent before competing or risk being denied entry to the competition. - PCR results will be sent via email within 24 hours, rapid antigen tests results will be available within 20 minutes

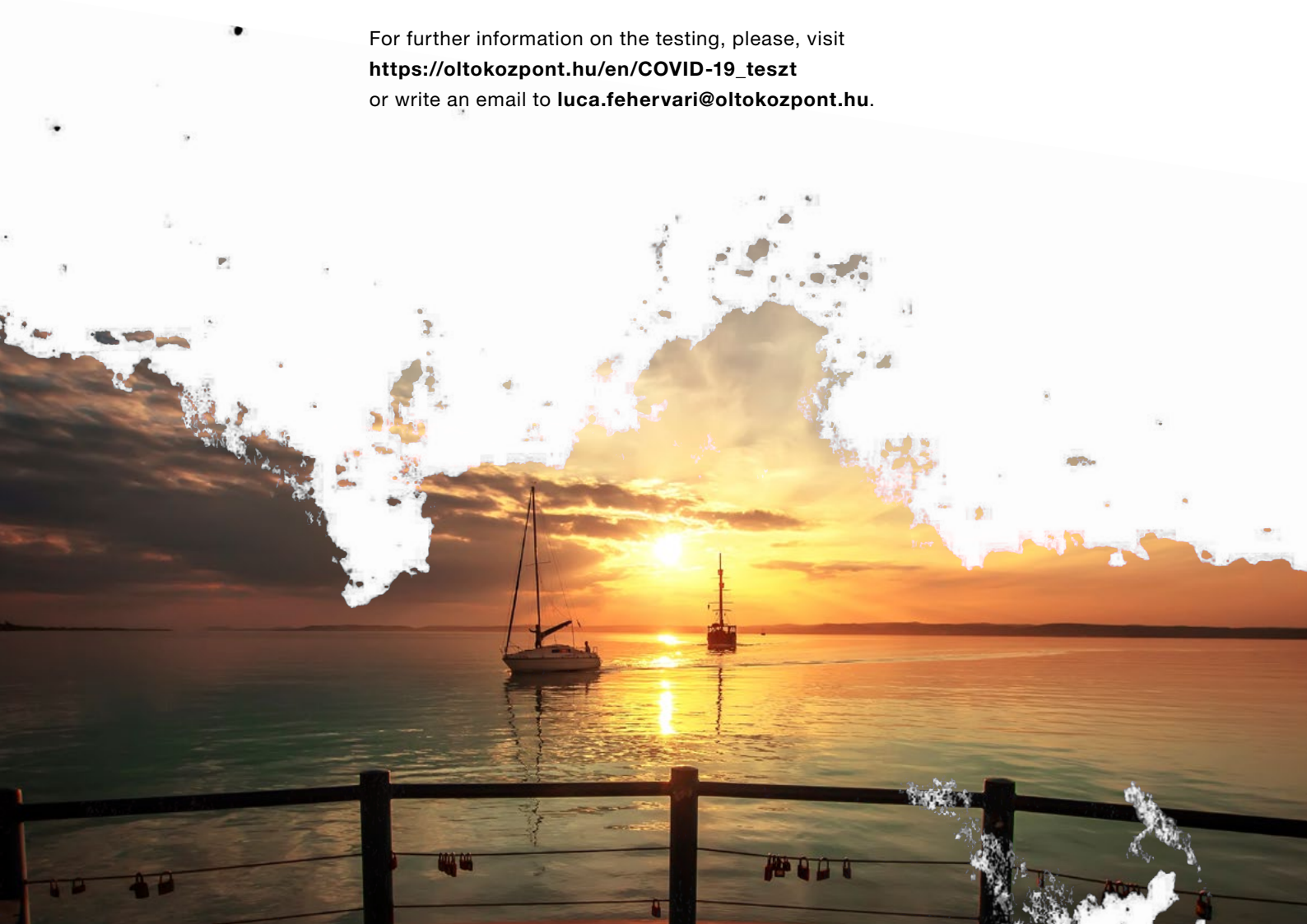
