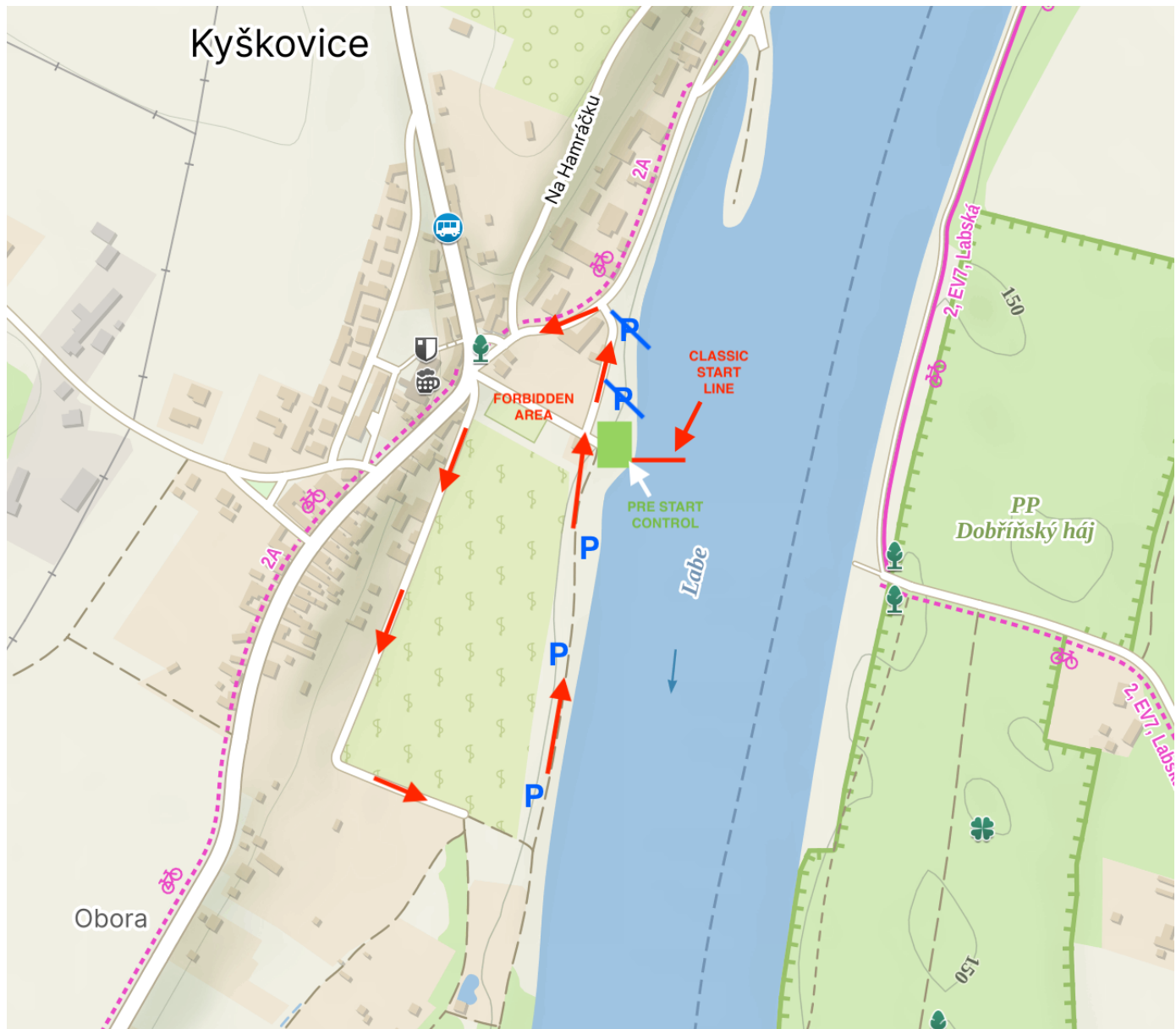

### 13. Closing of the course

The course is closed 15 min before the first official start each day until 20 minutes after the last athletes pass the finish line on the whole course

### 14. Pre-Start Control

The pre-start control will be near the boat entrance:



## 15. Start and Finish location and procedure

### A. Start procedure – individual events

- Boat will be held on the raft and released from 0 after the countdown has finished
- Athletes are responsible to get themselves to the start position on time.
- There will be a clock facing upstream into the warm-up area showing time
- One boat at the start and the following competitor could stay behind the raft.
- At the start will be an acoustic signal
- Athletes must start **within 3 seconds of** their start time.
- At all times, the athletes must follow the Starter's instruction, or they may be disqualified for the run/race.
- The course is closed 15 minutes before the first competitor – at the finish line.

## B. Start procedure – team events

- All boats will be held at the rafts.
- Moving backwards not allowed after starting signal
- It doesn't matter which of the three boats cross the start line at first. All boats must pass the beam line within **10 seconds from the "0"**.

## C. Finish

- The beam line will be indicated by banner.
- Athletes must exit on the river right and pass through equipment control
- Athletes must not leave the finish zone until dismissed by the equipment control judge once they are no longer needed for the ceremonies, anti-doping or equipment control.
- Just after final sprint run will be flowers ceremony – for the best three in each category
- During this process, each athlete must wear his competition bibs.

## 16. Course approval

The course must be approved by a simple majority of the present.

## 17. Start Interval

### A. Team events

- Sprint: 60 seconds
- Classic: 60 seconds

### B. Individual events

- Sprint Heats: 30 seconds
- Sprint Finals: 60-80 seconds – by the stream
- Classic: 60 seconds

## 18. Results

- Results will be posted on the official notice at the enquiry desk

## 19. Location of Enquiry / Protest desk, Protest fee

- The Enquiry desk is located in Race Office.
- Access to this area is limited to accredited Team Leaders only.
- The protest fee is 75 euro or equivalent in local currency
- The Chief Judge will review all the available information for the processing of the enquiry. Following the investigation of the enquiry the decision becomes a matter of fact and therefore cannot be protested further. An Enquiry is considered only when submitted within 20 minutes for classic and 5 minutes for sprint after the competitor's checklist is posted.

## 20. Equipment measuring and post competition control

- Equipment Control is located at the entrance to venue and is open for self-checking:



- Tuesday 04.07. from 10:00 to 18:30
- Equipment control station can be used also each day of competition 15 minutes before each Wildwater canoeing official training slot near the finish line.
- There will be random post equipment control
- airbags must be full pump. All other aspects following the rules.

## 21. Doping control

- The doping control station is located near Race Office.
- Athletes will be notified for Doping Control at the finish area.
- ID card or passport will be requested.

## 22. Awards Ceremony, Time and Location, Dress requirement

- Location: see map in appendix 1
- Schedule:
  - Classic individual and team medal ceremony, Nation Cup Classic: Thursday 06.07 from 16:00
  - Sprint individual and team medal ceremony, Nation Cup Sprint and closing ceremony : Saturday 08.07. from 18:30
  - Classic open international race prize ceremony: Wednesday 05.07 from **17:38**
  - Sprint open international race prize ceremony: Friday 07.07 from **19:20**
- For international ceremony – only very small gifts (sweets etc.).
- For events that are not valid, there will flower ceremony (without medals and anthems).

## 23. Water Safety and rescue

- The water rescue service will be located along the course as required.
- Please follow their instructions at all times.

## 24. Opening ceremony

Till Monday 18:00 o'clock.

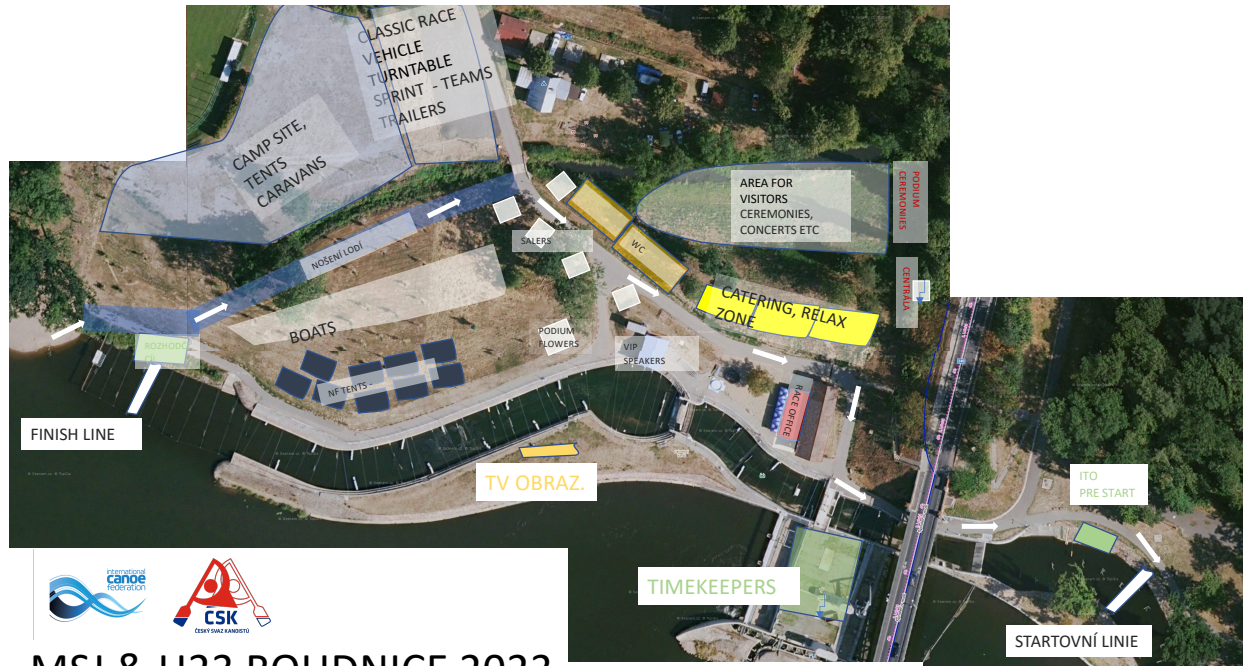
- Please send us a link to 1 song that will get your team moving as part of the opening ceremony. Let your team know that this song will be playing for them when they're on the stage and that it would be cool to perform something.
- Next, as part of the opening ceremony, each team will be asked to demonstrate what is in them, what their determination and strength is to go into the fight at the World Championships. We imagine teams getting ready for that and being prepared. Ideally,

you could talk about it, as a team, and bring something (an instrument, bells, ...anything) that makes a sound and can be used.

## 25. Venue

- **Boat storage – no boats on venue except boat storage area!** NF can use boat storage area for NF's trailers.
- NF can put their own tents on NF tents area.
- During race days – it is not allowed to carry boat through venue area. Athletes have to use footpath (already marked)
- Parking – NF can use parking place near access to venue. Spectators' cars are not allowed to use parking place on venue
