

Course arrangement



Blue line standard (long course), each lap is 2 km, 10 laps + 1 short lap

Total 21 km, first two laps no portage, so 8 portages. Portage appr. 60 metre long, sandy beach out and sandy beach in. Portage self on beach.

Short distance 3 laps, each lap 1,2 km, 2 portage. Yellow line shows turn for short laps.

Keep in mind that travel cost for athletes and team helpers must be paid by the national federation.

Accommodation, transportation, accreditation during July 8 - 13 are paid for the athletes by the organization, for more information about team helpers or coaches, see below. Accommodation in rooms with two beds, so 2 athletes share a room.

Arrive earlier is possible at additional costs shown below, but let us know as soon as possible if you intend to arrive earlier.

TEAM OFFICIAL ACCREDITATION COST INFORMATION

Team Officials (must have a function in in the sport) are responsible for the costs of their accommodation, meals and transportation.

The following options are available to extra team officials **once they are approved by IWGA**.

OPTION 1 — Accreditation + Athletes Village Accommodation — \$180.00 per person/day

Single Includes the following:

- Accommodation in a single room at the Athletes' Village.
- Accreditation ID card which allows access to venues, the athletes' village, opening and closing ceremonies, etc according to the access levels which are established for the cardholder by IWGA and BOC. (Accreditation levels for Extra Team Officials are evaluated in the same manner as all other accredited persons.)
- 3 meals per day at the catering centre on the campus of the Athletes' Village
- Transportation within the Games transportation network (airport venues, athlete villages)

OPTION 2— Accreditation + Athletes' Village Accommodation — Double \$120.00 per person/day

Includes the following:

- Accommodation in a double (shared) room at the Athletes' Village.
- Accreditation ID card which allows access to venues, the athletes' village, opening
 and closing ceremonies, etc according to the access levels which are established for
 the cardholder by IWGA and BOC. (Accreditation levels for Extra Team Officials are
 evaluated in the same manner as all other accredited persons.)
- 3 meals per day at the catering centre on the campus of the Athletes' Village
- Transportation within the Games transportation network (airport venues, athlete villages)

AVAILABILITY IS LIMITED. ACCOMMODATIONS ALLOCATED ON A FIRST-COME, FIRST-SERVED BASIS.

OPTION 3 — Accreditation Only \$55.00 per person/day

Includes the following:

- Accreditation ID card which allows access to venues, the athletes' village, opening
 and closing ceremonies, etc according to the access levels which are established for
 the cardholder by IWGA and BOC. (Accreditation levels for Extra Team Officials are
 evaluated in the same manner as all other accredited persons.)
- 3 meals per day at the catering centre on the campus of the Athletes' Village
- Transportation within the Games transportation network (airport, venues, athlete villages)

For accommodations outside of the athletes' village, Birmingham Organisation accommodation partner, National Travel Systems (NTS), will work with delegates to find solutions according to the delegate's budget. (contact Ruud Heijselaar for more information)

Delegates who are not accommodated within the Games transportation loop will be responsible for making their own way to the athletes' village for meal service, and/or to participate in the Games transportation system.

How can I get an invitation letter for athletes?

The following information have to be provided to generate visa letters for individual athletes and teams:

- Organization (IF)
- Last Name
- First Name
- Function
- Gender
- Date of Birth
- Place of Birth
- Nationality
- Passport Number
- Passport Issue Date
- Passport Validity Date

When and where should I apply for a VISA?

Due to the COVID pandemic and consulate closures all over the world, it is recommended that athletes/officials schedule interviews as early as possible in consulates of their country or neighbouring countries. National Travel Systems may assist you with providing contacts and facilitating interviews on time.




Medical Services – **Legal Practise**

- Legal Practise for foreign medical and paramedical officers is limited and restricted according to the specific decisions of the state governor taken specifically for the games.
- Request for treatments and analysis/test must come first from the participants through their official staff
- The BOC medical staff will work in close collaboration with them.

Medical Services - COVID

IWGA and BOC are very concerned and will strictly apply the updated US and Alabama regulations in force.

- * Practical experience of the Tokyo Olympics could be useful
- The national epidemic situation of the participating countries could have to be considered, with specific obligations, including quarantine etc.

Anti-Doping – Regulations

- IWGA's Anti-Doping rules effective 1 January 2021 are in full compliance with the WADA Code and will be strictly applied for TWG 2022 – as well as the WADA directives.
- IWGA remains the testing authority for the Games.
- A contract of collaboration with ITA has been signed to carry out the controls on the field.
- USADA as local NADO will be involved.
- · WADA will send observers.
